- Ghana IEEE Focus Group: This was a one-day event held on Tuesday 8th October, 2019 and hosted by the IEEE Ghana Section. The event was meant to draw practicing engineers, technical managers and policy makers closer to the IEEE. Stakeholders share thoughts on how to establish sustainable IEEE professional and continuing education for engineers in Africa. The event was well attended and was supported by the IEEE New Initiative.
- 2) IEEE AFRICON 2019: This event was organised and hosted by the Section. To get the industry closer to the IEEE, five (5) Chief Executive Officers from 5 key utility companies in the country were invited to the event: two (2) as guest speakers and three (3) as guest of honours. This has established a strong relationship between the Section and the companies.

Initiative for the Next 6 Months

1) The Section intends to Collaborate with the Energy Commission for Workshops: The Commission is mandated to license electrical contractors in the country. These contractors are occasionally trained by the Commission to keep them abreast with modern trends. As a professional body, we believe we can support the Energy Commission with experts from the IEEE fraternity. We have already initiated actions to collaborate with the Energy Commission in this exercise. It is expected this will make the Section more visible and attractive.
