During the past few months and following the London meeting, feedback information was gathered from all members of the subcommittees under my supervision. The members were asked to submit their remarks, comments, successes, failures and their recommendations. This was also followed up during various Skype conference meetings. Additional remarks on the operation and activities of the different subcommittees follow:

# Membership Development (MD)

Overall membership in the IEEE continues to grow. Total membership as of end of June 2011 stands at 371749 with an increase of 1.4% from last year. Region 8 membership stands at 67721 with an increase of 3.5% over last year.

Issues of concern which I urge section chairs to observe:

- First year retention rate for R8 is around 85% of the identified goal. I am sure we can improve this.
- Some sections still do not have an MD officer. Please appoint one. This issue was highlighted in the London meeting. Thank you for the sections which did respond to the call.
- e-membership (where applicable). We have achieved until June only 37% of eligible higher grade members. More focus on this issue is also required in the coming few months specifically after August.

The R8 MD subcommittee has initiated a new program to increase the membership of small sections. It substantial financial rewards for qualifying sections. Please see the details in the SF R8 MD report. Please also consult with the members of the subcommittee in SF.

# For Professional Activities (PA)

In these times of economic uncertainties, it is strongly felt that it pays to add value to our members through engaging them within the sphere of PA. To enhance this, it is important for sections to appoint a PA officer to work and coordinate these activities at the section and subsection level. Work is going on to put forward a proposal to this effect to be submitted at the section congress.

Additionally, a focus group is working on what is called thought leadership program to be run through the PA subcommittee. Please have a look at the SF PA report.

# Graduates of Last Decade (GOLD)

A highlight of GOLD activity in addition to the various support roles which can be seen in the GOLD report in the agenda book is the compiling, editing and printing of the GOLD book.
