






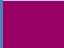
Sections Congress coordinator

Report

Sections Congress recommendation process was fulfilled during the past months.

1. All potential recommendations were recovered from the focus groups during the London meeting and the particular ones that have been sent through the online system.
2. All the recommendations were analysed to comply with the official regulations. Only a few were not considered due to lack of clarity or because they were already recommendations in the past.
3. An online survey was created for R8 Committee members to vote.
4. Poll was open for a few days, reminders were sent to vote and finally 62 votes were casted with the following reported results:
