IEEE Serbia and Montenegro Section in March 2011 has in total **651** Active Members (2 Life Senior, 1 Life Member, 2 Fellows, 29 Senior Members, 372 Members, 24 Associates to Members, 9 Affiliates to Members, 130 Graduate Student Members and 82 Student Members).

Collaboration with National Societies:
