Sections were asked to appoint contact persons who act as editors/authors for the history of their Section. The nomination process will be concluded at the end of September. For all those Sections from which no nomination was received the Section Chairman be will assumed to be the contact person. Of course for this activity the term as Section contact will not be terminated when a new chairman is elected unless the new chairman takes over this duty.

Also until the end of September the Technical Working Team (TWT) consisting of the Region Secretary, the Electronic Communication Officer, 1 student and 1 GOLD member will provide the template as well as information for the authors which will be presented at the Prague Meeting.

Meanwhile to each member of the Past Directors Council (PDC) a group of Sections was allocated which keep contact and cooperate with this member of the Editorial Board (= PDC) when needed.
