Membership (2010):

IEEE Serbia and Montenegro Section in September 2010 has in total **660** Active Members (2 Life Senior, 2 Life Member, 2 Fellows, 29 Senior Members, 417 Members, 24 Associates to Members, 16 Affiliates to Members, 84 Graduate Student Members and 86 Student Members).

The number of members is increased by **5.6%** comparing to the membership in April 2010, and by **8.4%** compared to the membership in September 2009. Five years growth is **34.4%** (660/491 members, Sept.2010/Feb.2006).

New Student Branch has been opened in Podgorica (Montenegro) on 28th April 2010, which will enable further student and membership growth in coming years.

Collaboration with National Societies:

Best practices:

The section has established close relation with most of the national organizations, student associations (EESTEC) and bodies which organize technical conferences in Serbia and provide technical co-sponsorship. During these conferences the section organizes the IEEE desk with IEEE volunteers and promotional material as a part of its membership development activities. As a result number of members is constantly rising and number of arrears is low (8.4% increase in period Sept.2010/Sept.2009 !).
