# Financial Statements and the Annual Report

- Statement of Activities (over fiscal yr)
  - Revenue minus expenses = surplus
- Statement of financial position (snapshot)
  - Investments are 2/3 of total assets
  - Assets minus Liabilities = Reserves
    - in the green zone again

# 2009 Statement of Activities\*

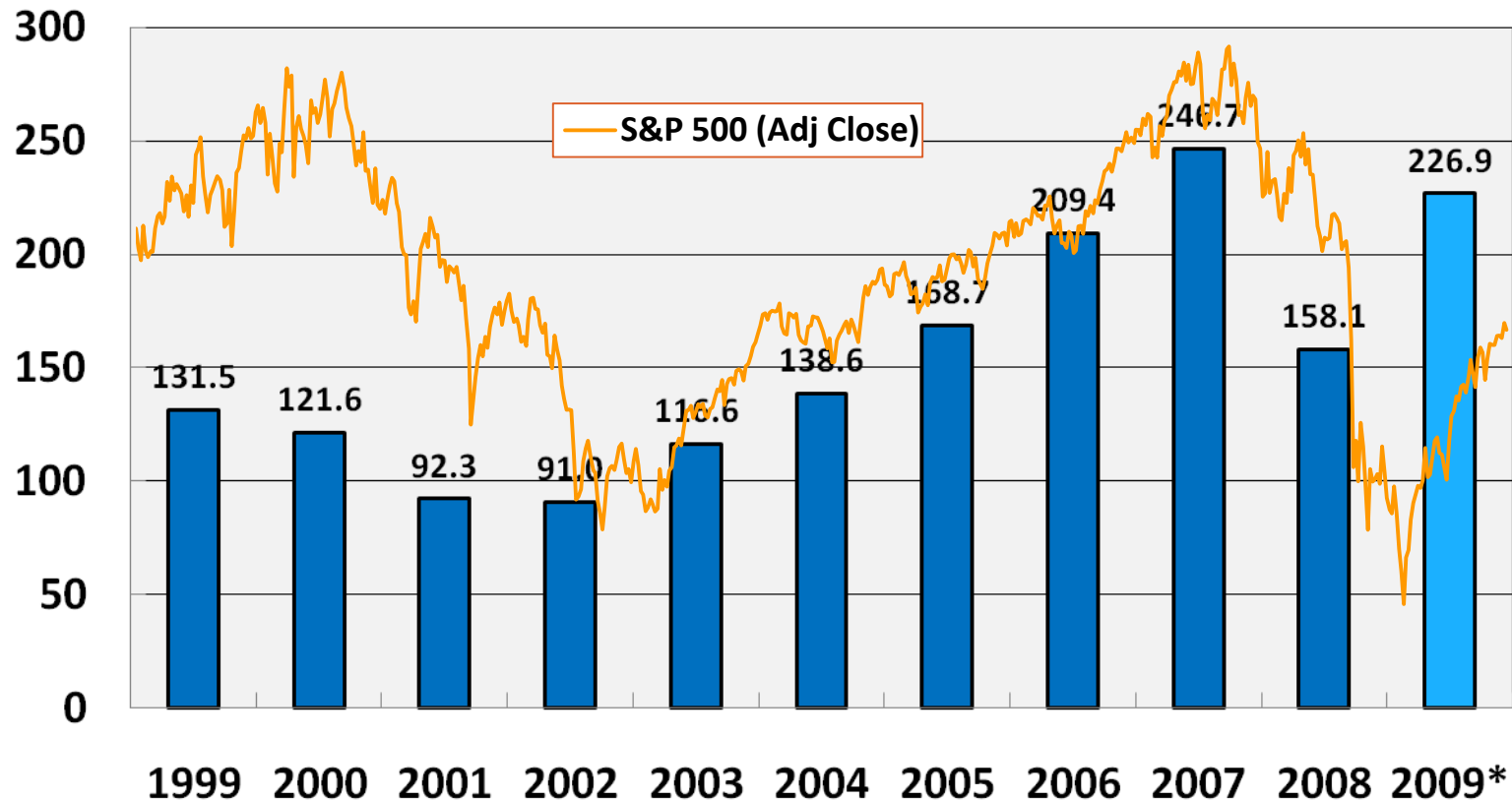

# Financial Statements and the Annual Report

- Statement of Activities (over fiscal yr)
  - Revenue minus expenses = surplus
- Statement of financial position (snapshot)
  - Investments are 2/3 of total assets
  - Assets minus Liabilities = Reserves
    - in the safe region again
