






ieee italy section - membership



trend over last 30 years is a steady +4.1% per year

ieee italy section - milestones



it's time we go organizing another big event !

recent golden event (2005):

- **merging** of North and Central-South Italy Sections
championed by myself and past Chairs
after 40 years of division
- **motivation**: one big Society can serve Members better, and has more visibility and influence !

- with about 4,250 members our Italy Section is:
- third largest in R8
- comparable in size to AEIT, the National Electrical and Electronic Engineer Association (6500 members)
- covers a broad range of expertise with its ~30 chapters

the Section in a nutshell:

- 4250 active members
 - 105 Fellows, 350 Seniors
 - 731 Students and Gold
- retention rate high (84%, 4th place in R8)
- steady increase (+4.5%) over last 2 years
(4.1% on the last 30 years)

ExCo meetings:

we call 4 **Executive Committee Meetings** every year since 2005, to:

- **review** Chapter and AG activity
- **stimulate** SB and Gold participation
- **rejuvenate** inactive Chapters
- prepare **MoU/MoA** with National Associat'n
- **support** Chapters funding and organizing lectures, workshops and conferences
- approve **budget**

chapters:

29, of which 17 **large** (>100 members) and 12 **small** (<100 members):

and 18 **Student Branches**: BO, PD, Roma, TS, MI, GE, TO, BA, PV, PI, CT, PR, Roma2, FI, VR, SA, NA, Calabria

chapters (2)

- most Chapters report significantly **more events** than the **2** x L31 minimum requirement
- a few of Chapters are very active with **10+ event** per year, including DL lectures, 1-day workshops and national/international co-sponsored events:

LEO36, C016, VT06/COM19, SSC37,
GRS29, SMC28, EMC27

Recently, two R8 CotY awards were earned (2002 and 2007) by the **LEO36**, who also was the recipient of 6 more awards from its Society.

meetings at Chapters:

- about 30 Distinguished Lecturers from Societies deliver their talk at our Chapters each year
- and we reciprocate: presently there are 4 DLs from Italy**
- a dozen 1-day workshops organized annually
 - several IEEE Conferences have been initiated or are supported locally, including
 - IEEE LEOS Winter Topicals - IEEE Sensors 08
 - IEEE Nanotechn. Conf- 2008 IEEE Radar Conf
- next year we co-organize the:
- IEEE Workshop On Health Care Management (Venice, Feb.18-20, 2010) on MoU with SMC Chapter

Section-organized meetings:

we want to follow up with a bold activity and are preparing a new, interdisciplinary conference on:

“Complexity in Electrical and Communication Engineering” (Rome, Feb.2010)

we have also submitted proposals to run:

- HISTELECON 2011 in Pavia
- ENERGYCON 2012 in Rome
- MELECON 2014 in Milano

we have a good relationship and MoUs signed with the National Society AEIT for local organization of events

our website www.ieee.sezione-italia.it

- designed by the our Communication Coordinator *T. Tambosso* using the IEEE model
- hosted at the Computer Center, University of Pavia
- in operation since 2007
- has several Sections: *Chapter Roster, Documents, ExCo, Student Branch, Gold, Events, Calendar, News*
- receives an average of 500+ hits per months
- is used to vote Section balance

This month we had **654** visitors

Best practice

- in 2008, a 'Manual of Expenses of Chapters' has been prepared and released for use.
- a Chapter Chair Support Folder (size 150MB) has been readied, intended as a help in establishing correct relationship in Meetings organization.
- a list of MoU and MoA drafts prepared and circulated for use
- big effort spent in helping Chapter Chairs to organize their activity and conferences under compliance to MGA and TAB directives.

Best practice (2)

- We try to involve deeply **GOLD** and **young** Volunteer in Section activity and governance
- Section has sent Gold Coordinator to attend **SBC** (London) and **Sibircon**
- sent CS ViceChair Stefano Zanero, 34, as **Section Primary Delegate** to Section Congress **SC-08** in Quebec City
- program of **Awards** (\$500) to **PhD** Members in several Chapters (LEO, GRS EMC, SMC...)
- tried to establish a **Joint Award** AEIT-IEEE for a young Member

IEEE 125th Anniversary activities:

- Applications for IEEE Milestones plaques submitted for:

A. Volta (Pavia),

G. Marconi (Pontecchio M., Bologna)

A. Meucci (Firenze, tbs)

Ceremony involving local authorities and the press is on the way.

- Other **Special Events** planned (presence at *SMAU* Fair, Milano, and event in Roma) to outreach IEEE, scopes, activity, and products

Italian Members appreciate most:

- the Societies and the *broad* coverage of *specializations* they offer, even *wider* than name

- *Networking* with *colleagues* worldwide
- Perception of IEEE *Journals* as the vital vehicle of *scientific dissemination* of discovery
- IEEE Conferences as site for discussion and *cross-fertilization of ideas*
- the *international environment* created by Societies and their Distinguished Lecturers
- a feeling of a *scientific brotherhood* between IEEE colleagues
