Feedback Results from Arrears

- Several Section MD Officers responded
- Almost 10% of members in arrear responded
- Results:
 - > 30 − 40% renewed after reminder
 - > 15% too expensive, benefits not worth dues
 - > 17% no need for IEEE membership anymore
 - > 13% out of technical business
 - > 16% magazines not received regularly and others
