What we have done in February to Retain Membership

On 10 February 2009 our Region 8 MD Team (Aleksandar Szabo and Ali El-Mousa) prepared and sent out more than 14,000 *personal letters* by e-mail to all our professional IEEE members who didn't renew. For the Subject of the letters we put "Invitation by the IEEE Region 8 Subcommittee". We pointed out the IEEE member benefits and gave several useful information concerning renewal. We received thousands of replies and learned a lot about the reasons why many members didn't renew. There are many cases in which members sent their renewal but they were still in the pre-arrears list. Sometimes members don't find their way in contacting Staff persons and there is often a lack of communication or there are difficulties in the location of the money. As a positive outcome many members renewed after receiving our letter and we could see in SAMIEEE the number of pre-arrears going down faster than usually.

Arrears – The Most Important Issue at the Moment

Members who did not renew until the end of February have been put into **Arrears** by the IEEE Service Terminator. They lost their membership rights, IEEE service to them was terminated, and they are not receiving their publications anymore. At the end of February we had 17,847 Arrears in Region 8.

Now we are asking Section MD Officers and Section Chairs to remind the Arrears to renew. Send them a nice letter. Explain them the IEEE member benefits. Many members are very busy and they just forgot to send their renewals on time... To get an idea you can use the letter we sent out in February to Pre-Arrears by adjusting it and possibly translating it for your Section. Here is the letter:

We sincerely hope that you are doing well.

Perhaps you forgot, but we still have not heard from you regarding your 2009 IEEE membership. We don't want to lose you as a valuable member, but unfortunately your IEEE membership is past due and your benefits and services stop by the end of February.

Or you can mail your renewal invoice (received from IEEE) with payment to IEEE to continue enjoying your member benefits.

The Half-Year Dues Period – Recruiting New Members is Easier

The half-year dues period is the **peak recruitment time**. It allows people to test IEEE membership for a smaller initial fee. **New members pay half-year dues** when they sign up from 1 March through 31 August. Services commence immediately upon joining and continue through December 31. Members joining in March receive a **bonus of 4 months** of extra service above and beyond the six months they are paying for. For Membership Development Resources visit:

February 2008 Membership Statistics

At the end February 2009 Region 8 had 53,092 members. Comparing to the number of 50,932 members at the end of February 2008 this is an increase of 2,160 members or 4.2%. The professional membership increased by 562 members, while the student membership increased by 1,598 student members. We should intensify the membership recruitment and recovery in Sections and Student Branches.
