Pre-Arrears and Arrears

Pre-Arrears are members who didn't renew for 2009. To prevent the situation of having many **arrears** in March 2009, we should contact our members, explain the **member benefits** and move them to

RENEW BEFORE THE END OF FEBRUARY 2009!

Members who will not renew until the end of February will be put into **Arrears** by the IEEE Service Terminator and they will loose their membership rights, IEEE service will be terminated, and they will not receive their publications anymore.

Region 8 Membership

At the end of 2008 Region 8 had 67,221 members. Comparing to the number of 64,976 at the end of December 2007 this is a total increase of 2,245 members or 3.46%. The higher grade members still have a respectable 2.8% increase in membership. The student members (including graduate student members) have an increase of 5.2%. We should intensify the membership recruitment in Sections and Student Branches.
