At the end of the 2010 Membership Year in our Region we could retain three of four 2009 members. IEEE's Member database flags members for GOLD affiliation based on the date of the member's first graduation. Members are identified as "Yes GOLD" if their graduation date is less than 10 years past. At present, graduation dates are an optional field for member applications so new members joining IEEE are categorized as GOLD **IF** the graduation date is provided. Graduating Student Members are captured as they are elevated from Student Member to higher grade member following their graduation date.

The GOLD member data above only captures those IEEE members that are "Yes GOLD" flagged. Efforts are underway to investigate methods for reflecting true numbers of IEEE members who have graduated in the last decade.

In SAMIEEE, there are several pre-defined queries for GOLD: In the Geographic Folder, (GEO) Active IEEE members –Current GOLD (Graduates of the Last Decade) and (GEO) Active Student & Graduate Student Members with Graduation Date in 2010. In the SAMIEEE MD folder, (MD) Active Student Members with Graduation Date will also pull data.
