1. Highlights from the past

- Sub-Committee meeting in London on March 25th, 2011 45 attendees. 23 societies representatives.
 - Very dynamic meeting defining the ChCSC policy headlines.
- Chapter chairs meeting in Bucharest on June 29th, 2011

 Before ECAI conference in Piteşti (June 30th-July 2nd, 2011)

 26 attendees from 5 countries. Contributions sent by 3 other countries. Many useful outcomes
- Chapter chairs meeting in Manchester on October 10th, 2011 During European Microwave Week (Oct. 9th-14th, 2011)
 - Co-organized with MTT Society
 - 40 chapter representatives plus 23 student members. Helpful presentations on vTools and of paper presentation advices.
 - Participation of MTT-S and AP-S presidents for defining common actions.
- Chapter chairs meeting in Hammamet on March 25th, 2012 During MELECON (March 25th-28th, 2012)
- Webinar "Chapter chairs training" on November 3rd, 2011 with Cheryl Sinauskas 20 attendees. The webinar covered vTools and the Centre for Leadership Excellence (CLE).

- Best chapter award: 14 applications received (13 last year)

Difficulty to evaluate the impacts of the actions. More active chapters better than more numerous chapters if many of them are inactive Numerical results difficult to define
