4. POINTS OF CONCERN / TOPICS FOR FUTURE DISCUSSION

Serious concern regarding proposal of IEEE HQ about new structure of Sections put forward in San Francisco Meeting for better management of accounting (proposal to transform the Sections into branches of the IEEE).

Discussed in the Italy Section Exco; serious reasons to disagree based on:

- 1. The IEEE Italy Section is an Association based in Italy needing to comply to Italian Law
- 2. To operate in Italy necessary to respect Italian financial Law which is very strict and difficult to manage from abroad.

Disagreement was unanimously expressed by the Board.

One more concern is about the new tool for reporting of financial activity to the HQ. This is very complex and already required to hire an accountant, with additional costs upon the Section. Should be rethought and simplified.
