Workshop General Theme:

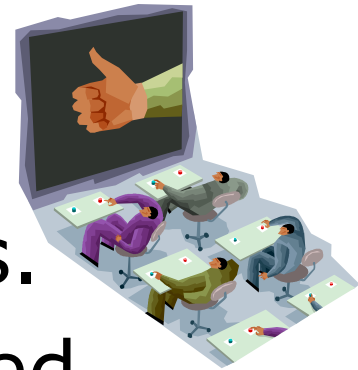
"Successful Events, the How and Why"
