 - Including student events

- Engages in member development

General focus points for 2013-14

- Revitalize less active Sections, Chapters, Affinity Groups, Student Branches
- Help Subsections that reside directly under the Region to become a full Section
- Explore the possibility for new Geographic Units in those parts of our Region where no Sections exist
- Assist with the legal registration of Sections where required

- Be aware of the diversity in the Region (for instance, with respect to Member Development, Women in Engineering, Industry Relations, ...)
- Be aware of compliance and governance vs. frustration of volunteers (for instance, with respect to Section registration, Section reserves, Section Officers term limits, mandatory use of financial software, ...)

Additional remark on mandatory use of financial software. The MGA Directors Forum during the Board Series in Austin, TX, February 2013, was mainly devoted to NetSuite. The proposed use of NetSuite on a transactional basis is likely to lead to a manual duplication of all bank transactions of Organizational Units. In my opinion this is unacceptable and will scare many (new) Treasurers; our volunteers should organize activities and should not be required to fulfill unnecessary administrative actions. Such mandatory use is only acceptable when NetSuite is able to import bank transactions automatically.
