Points of concern / Topics for future discussion

- Serious concerns regarding the proposal of the IEEE HQ about a possible new structure of Sections. It
 was discussed in the last meeting of the IEEE Italy Section ExCo; Disagreement was unanimously
 expressed by the the ExCo mainly because:
 - \circ The IEEE Italy Section is an Association that needs to comply with Italian Law
 - To operate in Italy we have to respect Italian financial Law, which is very strict and difficult to manage from abroad.
- One more concern is about the new tool for reporting the financial activity (NetSuite). This tool is very complex and not yet well defined. Thus it required a lot of effort by the Section Treasurer.
