Recent and upcoming IEEE Milestones

First breaking of Enigma code by the team of Polish Cipher Bureau, 1933-1939

- Warsaw, Poland, dedicated 5 October 2014 the first Milestone in the Poland Section
- Polish Cipher Bureau mathematicians Marian Rejewski, Jerzy Różycki and Henryk Zygalski broke the German Enigma cipher machine codes.
 Working with engineers from the AVA Radio Manufacturing Company, they built the `bomba' - the first cryptanalytic machine to break Enigma codes. Their work was a foundation of British code breaking efforts which, with later American assistance, helped end World War II.

Rheinfelden Hydroelectric Power Plant, 1898-2010

- Rheinfelden, Germany, to be dedicated 25 September 2014 the first Milestone in the Germany Section
- First generation and experimental proof of electromagnetic waves, 1886-1888

- Karlsruhe, Germany, dedication date to be decided
