

Full Year Report for 2014**Brian R Harrington**
Treasurer: IEEE Region 8**Overview:**

The Treasurer is pleased to report to the Region 8 Committee on the financial position of IEEE Region 8 as at the 31st December, 2014.

A comparison of the year 2014 expenditure figures with those for the year 2013 will show that the attendance of Region 8 members at the Sections' Congress and at the Region 8 Committee meeting in Amsterdam, and Region 8 support for Student and Young Professional activities, accounted for the larger expenditures.

However, Region 8 continues to make good progress financially with useful increases in the Cash position and with an increase in overall Net Worth.

Notes on Expenditures:

1. The \$249,510:58 shown for the Sections' Congress includes Region 8 Committee travel to Amsterdam. It includes the cost of the Region 8 Committee meeting and our accommodation in Amsterdam.

This amount is offset by the income figure of \$57,478:15 recovered from IEEE against these expenses.

2. Region 8 supported the Student and Young Professional congress in Kraków to the amount of \$37,500:00. Additional payments were made to assist needy students with travel, which with other occurring costs increased this. However, an amount of \$29,000:00 that had been set aside as Region 8 risk against this meeting were not needed and will be set against the next SYP congress which is scheduled for 2016.
3. The Region 8 News (Publication Expenses) is budgeted at \$70,000:00 per annum. The variation seen between the year 2013 and the year 2014 figures is owing to the dates each year on which charges due to the Region 8 News are received from IEEE Publications.
4. The figure for Travel as shown for the year 2014 is lower as the costs of travel to Amsterdam are included with the Sections' Congress expenses.
5. The caption "IEEE Region 8 Committee" includes our ongoing costs for Region 8 Committee meetings and will include staged payments, for example, made in 2014 towards our meeting in Limassol. It is OpCom practice to ideally plan each Region 8 Committee meeting up to twelve months in advance.

Notes on Income:

1. Income was assisted during 2014 by an additional \$29,176:69 which is the agreed share due to Region 8 of any surplus arising from our strategic Region 8 conferences such as EUROCON, MELECON, and AFRICON.

2. The basic income for Region 8 activity is derived from Assessment income and from the Direct Regional Support from MGA. These amounts are sensitive to membership numbers.
3. There is room for improvement in the income from Donations (Voluntary Contribution Fund) and that received from Technical Co-sponsorship.
4. The Long Term Investment Fund that is managed for us by IEEE continues to provide a welcome dividend and is ensuring a progressive increase in our Assets.

Audit:

The Region 8 Treasurer advises the Region 8 Committee that the financial accounts of the Region are subject to an Independent Review each year. This Review includes all reports made to the Committee by the Treasurer, Committee meeting Agenda Books, OpCom reports, and a download of the software system used for accounting and banking.

Audit follows the process as is specified by IEEE, together with other tests that have been constructed by the auditor to prove the integrity of the data submitted.

An extensive review of the accounts for the year 2013 was completed by October of 2014. A meeting in London for the close down of the accounts for the year 2013 was attended by Debbie Reyes, Senior Director of IEEE Internal Audit.

The auditor's management report arising from the meeting was presented to Region 8 OpCom at their meeting in London in November, 2014 and sets out the process to be followed for expense authorisation in Region 8.

Outlook:

The Treasurer thanks the Region 8 Committee for its care when incurring expenditures.

The "Statement of Net Worth" as shown confirms that we are improving our Cash position, which has been a concern over recent years. The Net Worth of the Region continues to increase, but is suggesting a position of being over capitalised.

It is the Treasurer's hope that the Cash position will continue to increase and enable the Region to return such surplus that may be achieved back into the Region 8 Sections and Chapters to assist with their own development. This will only be achievable if membership development remains positive.

Attempts are being made to address the de-motivators that are frustrating membership development and that impact upon Region 8 vitality. These include the issues with financial reporting and an apparent lack of understanding of Region 8 needs and operations within particular parts of IEEE.

In the past IEEE Region 8 has been recognised as an innovator on many aspects of Institute operations. Our strategy is to further support this together with our programme of Region activity.
