► **What is our Goal?**

- Revitalize inactive Student Branches (SBs) to be active again
- Improve communications between Sections & their SBs by ensuring that there is a Student Activities Officer and Section Student Representative (SSR) reported for all Sections in IEEE Region 8.



► How do we achieve this?

- Contact inactive student branches using the last recorded Officer details.
- Ensure that there is a Student Activities Officer and Section Student Representative (SSR) reported for all the Sections in IEEE Region 8.
- Prevent newly formed student branches from becoming dormant.
- Preapproval forms for new SBs
- We can only achieve this **with Your help!**



► What are the results so far?

- 38/56 Sections had **appointed SAC officers**
- 15/56 Sections had **appointed SSR Officers** and
- Only 12 Sections have **appointed both SAC and SSR Officers.**
- Out of **52 Sections and Subsection Chairs that were contacted**, **only 12 responded to the call** for them to appoint the required Officers for their Section.
- **Newly approved units in 2015:** 37 Student Branches, 20 new Student branch chapters and 12 new Student Branch Affinity Groups as of September 2015.
