MGA Awards

- **MGA Outstanding Large Section Award**
MGA Outstanding Medium Section Award
MGA Outstanding Small Section Award
three awards given annually (one for each category)
- Small = 500 or fewer members (in all member grades)
Medium = 501–1500
Large = 1501 or more
- IEEE Region 8 currently has **two categories** for Section awards and the Awards and Recognition Subcommittee is considering switching to **three** to align with MGA

- MGA Larry K. Wilson Transnational Award, one annually
- MGA Innovation Award, one annually
- MGA Leadership Award, up to three annually
- MGA Achievement Award, up to six annually
(only four were given in 2015!)
- MGA Young Professionals Achievement Award, up to six annually (only four were given in 2015!)

IEEE TAB awards

- At present Region 8 does not give an award that recognises outstanding technical contributions by an individual who pursued an industrial career. This proposal addresses that gap by virtue of a new award, named:
- The IEEE Region 8 Career Achievement Award:
 - **The award would be given to an individual from Region 8 for outstanding technical achievements (including leadership excellence) during a lifetime career spent in industry.**
 - **The award would be sponsored by Life members in Region 8, who would be responsible for the administration of the award and raising any funds needed.**
 - **A working group would be set up to determine the scope of the award, the eligibility criteria for the nominees, the composition of the jury, and the nature of the prize to be awarded.**
- The first step in the process to get an award approved is for the Region 8 Awards and Recognition Sub-Committee to review the proposal and make recommendations. The next stage would be for the Region 8 Committee to consider the proposal and to submit it to MGA for final approval. The IEEE Awards Board might also request some oversight.
- Comments and suggestions from members of the Region 8 A&R Sub-committee would be welcomed, before further consideration at the next A & R meeting in Monaco on 18 March.

- IEEE Region 8 approves the change in the categorisation of the IEEE Region 8 Outstanding Section Awards from two categories (small, large) to three categories (small, medium, large).
- The categories small, medium and large are defined as in the equivalent MGA award (MGA Outstanding Section Award).
