# Student Branch Chapters (SBC)

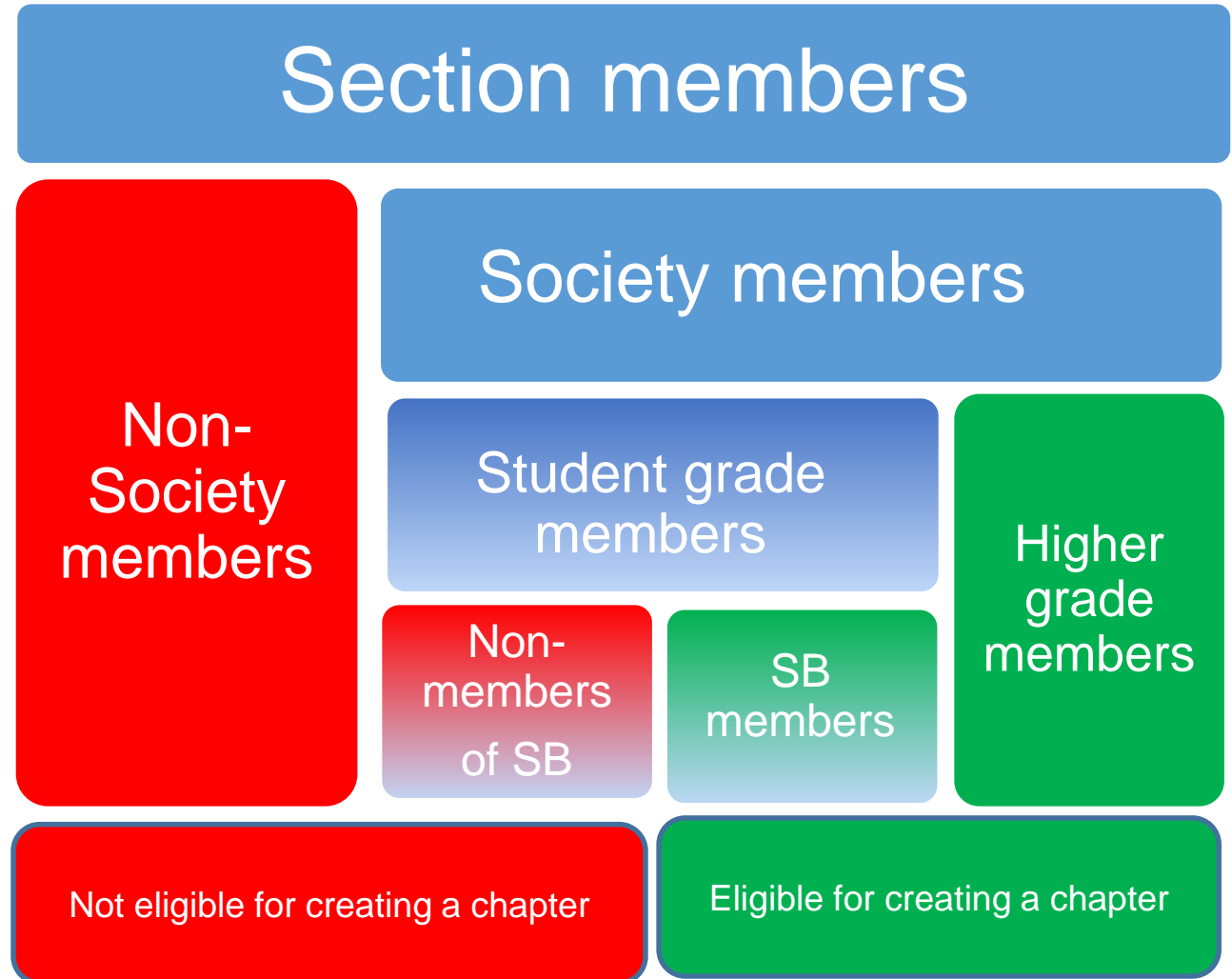
Issue raised by Peter Magyar

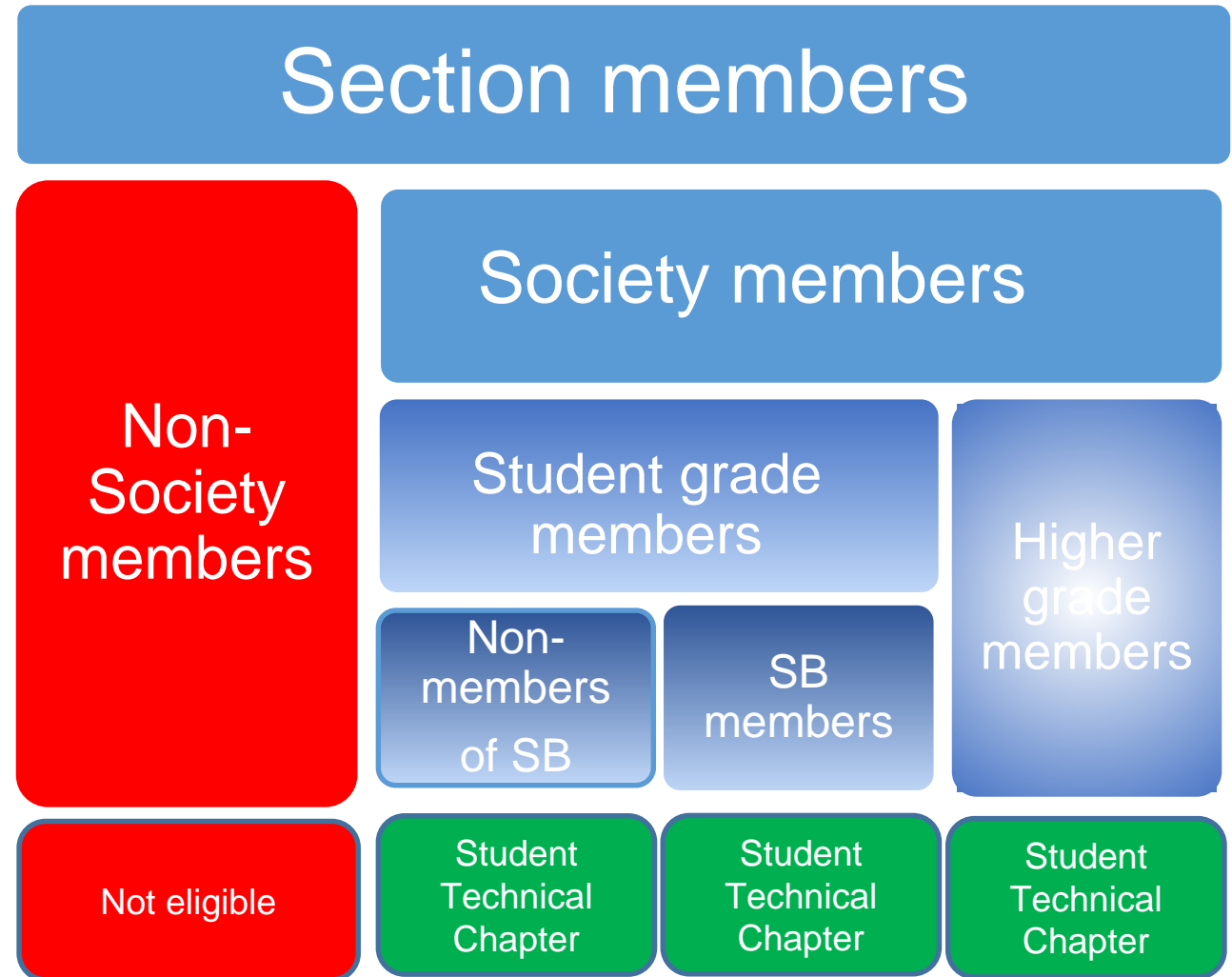
Current situation of formation of IEEE Chapters
