

Status of R8 MD, August 2018

Region Snapshot	This Month	'18 vs. '17	% Change
Total Membership	69,701	 806	+1.2%
Higher-Grade	52,828	 490	+0.9%
Students	16,873	 316	+1.9%

The 2018 membership year ended with strong growth (1.2% YoY), outpacing last year, when we ended the year in decline (-1.1% YoY). 22 Sections that met both their recruitment and retention goals (10 in 2017), 32 sections that met recruitment goals (25 in -2017) while 28 sections exceeded retention targets (21 in 2017).

SIGHT/HuAC R8 Activities for 2018

- 1) PROJECT MANAGEMENT TRAINING FOR SYP IN GREECE AND PORTO (March – June);
- 2) FINAL YEAR PROJECTS REVIEW FOR FORTY-FIVE (45) TURKEY IEEE SBs (Sakarya University, August);
- 3) AN EXPOSÉ AT ITALIAN IEEE EVENT (Politecnico di Milano, September);
- 4) SOLAR ENERGY FOR ILLUMINATION IN UNSERVED LOCATIONS (July – October);
- 5) AFRICAN ENERGY COMPETITION PARTNERSHIP (APRIL);
- 6) WOMEN EMPOWERMENT SCHEME THROUGH SOLAR ENERGY (July – October);
- 7) REGIONAL SYP CONGRESSES (June – November);

Region 8 Life Members Affinity Group (LMAG) Activities

(from March 18 to Octobre 18)

- **Administrative Status :**
- No R8 LMAG is recently dissolved
- Compared to other IEEE Regions, R8 has the highest number of active LMAG : 13
- 23% of total R8 Sections have LMAG : more effort has to be done for increasing this percentage. Efforts are started with Sweden Section (LM counts 100)
- Total number of meetings for R8 LMAGs : 32,(highest : 10 from France LMAG),
- Only the Greece LMAG had not reported 2 meeting for 2017,
- **LMAGs Milesones Activities in R8 :**
- Many LMAGs in Sections in R8 participate with the History Committee to propose IEEE Milestones :
- *A milestone plaque at Dundee University in Scotland on 5 April 2018 where Spear and LeComber carried out their experiments which led directly to the world of flat screens and smartphones we live in today,
- *The French Transatlantic Telegraph Cable, 1898. IEEE President James Jefferies unveiled two plaques (English and French versions) in Orleans, MA. on September 6, 2018

Region 8 Life Members Affinity Group (LMAG) Activities **(from March 18 to Octobre 18)**

- **Following my Proposals forward to R8 OpCom during its 2018 Summer meeting**
:
- The OpCom approved my proposal for organising a meeting for LMAG responsables in R8 together with the R8 meeting, If this can be arranged, Region 8 can provide funds
- * OpCom suggests that, before creating an LM full committee, to create a team of volunteers now, and show activity, For this purpose, a team is formed composed of the R8 LMAGs Cordonitor (Chair) and the 3 corresponding members as members , Contacts and activities organization of this team are made through e-mail and telephone conferences.
- * **A message was sent to R8 Section Chairs on August 13, 2018,**
- In this message, it was recommended :
 - that each Section should have a LM Coordinator to serve on the Section EXCOM to represent the interest of all older members.
 - the inclusion on the Section website of the name and contact details of the Coordinator, and the provision of a space on the website for news of interest to Life members.
- Over the 13 R8 Sections that have LMAG, I have received 8 answers : 5 had applied completely our recommendations and 3 had applied them partially



- ▶ Application for a grant to support HISTELCON made to IEEE Foundation.
- ▶ History Committee Chair, Bob Dent, is promoting Milestones to recognise space programme achievements, to correspond with 2019 being 50th anniversary of human landing on the moon. Should be some in the Sections of Region 8, and perhaps could be 'fast-tracked' through approval processes.
- ▶ LMAGs encouraged to try to interest retiring IEEE members who are not yet qualified to become Life Members (often the case in Region 8, where members joined IEEE well into their career and not as students)
- ▶ Mike Geselowitz, Senior Director at IEEE History Center, proposes to run an IEEE REACH (*Raising Engineering Awareness through the Conduit of History*) workshop alongside HISTELCON 2019. Such workshops are aimed particularly at teachers involved with children.
