

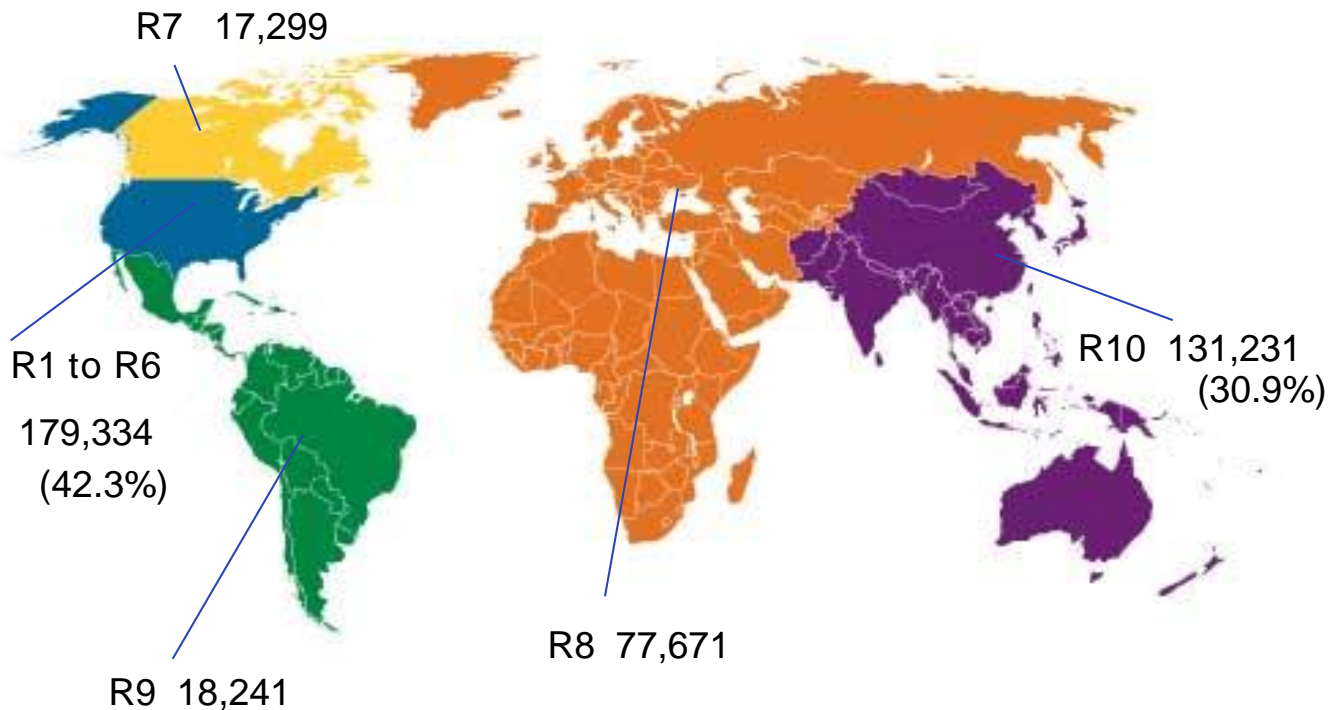

# IEEE Region 10 History

- IRE had 7 Regions in the U.S.A., Region 8 was Canada, and Region 9 covers other countries.
- When IEEE was formed in January 1963, the number of Regions in the U.S.A. was reduced to 6, and Canada became Region 7. New Region 8 was formed comprising Europe, Middle East and North Africa. The rest of the world was Region 9 till 1966
- Region 9 was limited to South America and the “rest of the world” became Region 10 in 1967
- Southern Africa was transferred from Region 10 to Region 8 in 1981
- Region 10 was described as Asia-Pacific Region in 1981
