

Professional and Education Subcommittee

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Goals

According to R8 Operations Manual (OpMan) the mission of the Professional and Education Subcommittee is to develop non-technical skills programs (such as "Leadership Skills Training" or "Project Management") in order to provide additional value to members, in particular to young engineers and students. To coordinate educational activities programs in Region 8 including pre-university education, university-level education, post-university (continuing) education and the promotion of public awareness of engineering, technology and other topics within IEEE's Field of Interest.

To recruit volunteers to implement professional and educational seminars and workshops in R8 and to train local Tutors (Trainers) for these activities.

The first goal was to create a new committee. The following are the members and their roles:



The table below is a summary of 11 objectives established. 5 are new proposals and 3 others are being improved or redone. The team is focused on three categories, pre university, university activities, continuing education. We have reached out to different OU including YP, WIE and SAC student branches to better improve the presence of PEASC. We are working with different regions particularly region 9 and 10 to address diversity and promote the use of different languages. We are also discussing with EAB to offer different ways of how these programs can be accessible to members in our region. We have updated the website but plan to restructure it and change the text to reflect better the way programs are designed. The speaker program invitation to nominate new speakers is launched. We are inviting distinguished speakers to nominate themselves focusing on non technical subjects. Check our website for more information.

As a committee all members are involved in various programs. Meetings are organised every two weeks and members also meet the chair of the committee to manage different goals related to their responsibilities. We already organised 5 meetings this year and 7 specific tasks meetings. Most members are new to the committee and we are proposing new programs that reflect the needs of the region. We also meet various members from

other committees and OU to participate and collaborate with us. So far we have a number of meetings and promote our goals such as the **language program** and **IEEE Robot Wars Championship**.

We are proposing the first Region 8 Education flagship event that can introduce a more practical aspect of IEEE PEASC in the region. This championship is named as the IEEE **Robot Wars Championship**. We have already achieved support from IEEE Malta Section, Cassar Marine Shipyard, Region 8, WIE and YP from the entrepreneurship team. A number of student branches have already shown an interest in participating and attending the event. We are part of the Entrepreneurship initiative contributing to the International Evaluation Committee to select the best 3 startups based on their 3-min pitching videos. We are organising events as part of the R8 meeting which cover 5 topics of interest about our activities.
