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Goals

IEEE R8 MDSC has been working in alignment with the IEEE Member Activities goals. We had previously agreed that a main priority for 2021, due to the pandemic, would be to emphasize *retention* over recruitment. The intent is that it is easier to keep members rather to encourage re-joining later. Luckily, the situation with membership has improved and the situation is not as bad as had previously been foreseen.

Again, due to the pandemic, opportunities for Volunteer Training events have been delayed. However, it is hoped that as the global situation improves due to vaccinations, etc., it may be possible to start holding in-person trainings in 2022, possibly in conjunction with IEEE events in February (EuMW, London), in May (ENERGYCON, Riga), in June (MELECON, Palermo) and during the IEEE R8 SYP Congress.

We are also discussing the organization of the Volunteer Leadership (Membership Development and Chapters Coordination) training in Glasgow in April.

Progress against goals since the last report

At the time of our last R8 (virtual) meeting, we reported that IEEE membership was down 4.4% year-on-year, with the lowest point being a loss of 6.9% in November 2020. We can report that membership overall is now up 1.9% on 2020 year-on-year. This means that overall membership is still down on 2019 but better than 2020. However, most of this is due to the FUTURES50 initiative with student membership up 13%. Unfortunately, higher grade membership is down 1.3%.





2021 Membership Year (Globally)

The trend in R8 is similar to IEEE overall, with 2021 numbers being higher than 2020 but still lower than 2019, as shown in the below graph. At 66,441 members, R8 membership is up 2.3% overall from the same month (September) last year, but down 1.2% in higher grades. Again, due to the FUTURE50 program, graduate student membership is up 3.9% and undergraduate membership is up a massive 26%.

Retention & Recruitment

Approximately 1/3 (33.9%) of sections in R8 have already reached or surpassed their recruitment goals. Almost 2/3 (62.7%) have reached their retention goals. Most other sections are well on target.
