Goals

- Establish WIE participation and visibility in R8 flagship events and international conferences: we intend to have very good representation, provide technical speakers, coordinate the active participation of R8 WIE in the defined events for 2021 (with a session, presentation, workshop, etc.).
- Increase the WIE membership in R8 and continue the growing trend achieved in past years.
- Identify women leaders in STEM and create a new program and award to encourage leaders in Technology, and rank them as experts or models to other IEEE Women in technology; Encourage IEEE STEM conferences in R8 to have women as organizing members, scientific members and plenary talk speakers.
- Have a close cooperation with the IEEE R8 Young Professionals, IEEE R8 Action For Industry and IEEE R8 Humanitarian Activities Subcommittees.
- Maintain collaboration with MGA WIE in the sense of active representation from R8 WIE in 2 Subcommittees of WIEC (WIEC SC <u>Women in Industry</u> + WIEC SC <u>ILS</u>).
- Establish the necessary coordination between R8 and MGA, keep the team updated on news from MGA and make use of the support of MGA when needed.
- Ensure high visibility of the activities organized and of the initiatives planned by R8 WIE by putting special effort on ensuring a high social media presence and keeping our website updated.
- **Have active and vibrant WIE AGs:** increase the vitality of Section and Student Branch Affinity Groups by getting closer to the active AGs, identify and revitalize dormant AGs.
- Increase the number of Section WIE AGs in R8: create AGs in the remaining sections with the help of Section Chairs.
- Enhance awards imprint and impact: Increase the awareness about R8 WIE programs and awards, by engaging WIE members; define clear and transparent selection criteria of awards.
- Have a yearly call online meeting with all R8 Section WIE AGs and their leadership.
- Collaborate with the newly established Diversity and inclusion subcommittee: identify common actions and
 activities.
- Collaborate more highly with WIE AGs and Section Chairs to achieve common goals: via direct e-mails, social media, meetings, etc.

Progress against goals since the last report

- We organized Mr. Stamatis Dragoumanos talk on "STEM portal" which took place online on May 19th 2021 and attracted great interest, recording is available.
- We provided support to various conferences/events.
- We had an active participation in various important conferences, please see below some examples from our team members:
 - ⇒ Sally Musonye participated with a talk on "Preserving history of women in engineering activities and affinity groups" on August 22nd 2021 at virtual International Women in Engineering COVID 19 Congress 2021 (WIECOV 2021).
 - ⇒ Maria-Alexandra Paun participated with an invited talk at online PowerAfrica 2021 on August 24th 2021 at the Panel "The Roles of Women Engineers towards Sustainable Development". R8 WIE was also Bronze Sponsor (1'000 USD).
 - ⇒ Maria-Alexandra Paun participated at online "Returning mothers conference" in "Diversity and Inclusion Efforts and impacts" Panel on 27th of August 2021.
 - ⇒ Maria-Alexandra Paun participated in the WIE panel within online RTSI 2021 conference on September 7th 2021.
 - ⇒ Dora Fourou participated in Nurturing Future Leaders Event held on September 11th 2021 and delivered a presentation of "Marketing Best Practices".
 - ⇒ Margarida Trigo participated on 19th of October as a speaker on the round table entitled by "Diversity Challenges in Engineering", along with Inês Direito (University College London), Maria Batista (Critical Software), Marisa Martins (WIT Software) and Shannon Chance (Technological University Dublin). The main topics and research discussed were related with academical and workplace environment integration for girls and women. Which measures can organisations adopt to retain female talent and how can organisations inspire girls to pursue tech careers. - An IEEE Entrepreneurship Meeting with Incoming 2022 Chair, Joanne Wong, took place on September 13th 2021.
- Our annual meeting with all R8 WIE AG Chairs took place via WebEx platform on October 14th 2021, 7-9 PM UTC+3 and attracted approximately 25 people, recording is available.
- Our R8 WIE website and social medial digital content is regularly updated (curated by Dora Fourou). We have taken great care of our social media by actively running the R8 WIE social media platforms (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram) to keep the followers updated with the latest news of the WIE R8 Subcommittee. We have a strong social media presence and digital communication which was emphasized and enhanced by various campaigns and special posts for example "October: Breast Cancer Month" (for more details see included Digital Communication presentation provided by Dora Fourou)
- We have worked on the inclusion pledge for R8 Fall Meeting.
- There is a continuous cooperation taking place with the IEEE R8 Young Professionals, PEASC, SAC using the model of Corresponding Members.
- We have strived and achieved a stronger collaboration with MGA WIE as well as a with societies via corresponding members of the team.
- We are motivated to provide mentorship towards members interested in WIE both via social media and via the participation in the different IEEE events.

Engineers Tunis (ENSIT), Women In Engineering Student Branch Affinity Group (March 23rd 2021)

- The number of IEEE WIE members is low even in high revenues countries, as the total number of female members is also low. Not all of them are IEE WIE members.
- There are still 20 sections that do not have a Section WIE AG. We hope that such WIE AG groups can be created in the future. E-mail will be sent out in October-November 2021 to Section Chairs that do not have a WIE AG.

• We are looking forward to a bright future of WIE in 2022, when the 25th anniversary will take place.


