### Section Vitality

All chapters regularly report their activities to the Section.

#### Industry

Industry relationships have been very active. Many activities were undertaken jointly with the key Polish and international industry: Intel, Samsung, Cisco, Roche, Netcompany, QWED, Opegieka, Billon, Solaris, 3mdeb. One of the most important actions is the student thesis competition, which takes place during the IEEE Day. In this year all companies have shown presentations in the following areas: AI, machine learning, blockchain, big data. Honorary guest of our IEEE Day was Prof. Ljiljana Trajkovic, who gave a fabulous speech "Data Mining and Machine Learning for Analysis of Network Traffic". The best students in IEEE Thesis Contest 2021 were awarded during the gala. The event was a great success.
