Goals

IEEE R8 MDSC has been working in alignment with the IEEE Member Activities goals. We had previously agreed that a main priority for 2021 and 2022, due to the pandemic, would be to emphasize *retention* over recruitment. The intent is that it is easier to keep members rather than encourage re-joining later.

Again, due to the pandemic, opportunities for Volunteer Training events have been delayed. However, we are planning to have virtual training with MGA MRRC in April and to start holding in-person trainings in conjunction with ENERGYCON (Riga, May), and MELECON (Palermo, June), and potentially other opportunities.

Progress against goals since the last report


R8 has reach 58.6% of its retention goals versus 58.5% at the same point last year. However, this is just below the IEEE overall retention rate of 58.7% , which is also down on last year.

At the time of our Frankfurt meeting we could report that membership overall was up 1.9% on 2020 year-on-year. However, most of this was due to the FUTURES50 initiative with student membership up 13%. Unfortunately, higher grade membership was down 1.3%.


Year-on-year, 2022 IEEE membership is up 3.5%; graduate student membership is up 6.1%, and undergraduate membership is up 23%. Unfortunately, higher grade membership is down a further 4.5%.

Region 8 is doing slightly better than IEEE overall – membership is up 5.4%, graduate student membership is slightly lower at 5.7% increase, but undergraduate students are up 36.3%. Higher grade membership is doing better than IEEE overall but is still down 1.3%.
