Recognizing that the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), the International Organization for Standardization (ISO), and the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) play a leading role in facilitating and harmonizing the global standardization efforts for sustainable digital transformation,

- Calls for continued collaboration between the international standards developing organizations (SDOs) including ITU, IEC and ISO as well as other standard-setting entities such as ETSI, IEEE, IETF, W3C, 3GPP (among others), to facilitate digital transformation.

- Works towards bridging the standardization gaps between developed and developing countries and scaling up of technology rollouts to achieve the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
