We have implemented the agreement (<https://ieeesiberia.org/rules/>), which contains the rules for conferences.

This agreement must be signed by all Conference Chairs of conferences organized by all Organizational Units (OUs) in the IEEE Russia-Siberia Section. These rules are based on the IEEE PSPB Operations Manual and are aligned with the IEEE Meetings, Conferences & Events (MCE). The rules are designed to be agreed upon in advance and to help organize a proper quality IEEE-style conference while respecting scientific ethics.

Section Vitality
