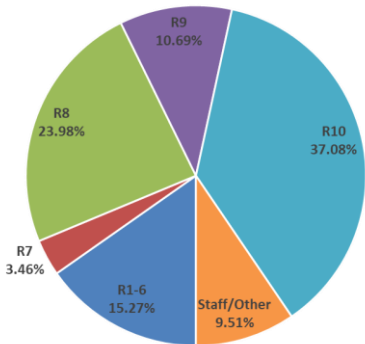

Active Users of 2021, by Region



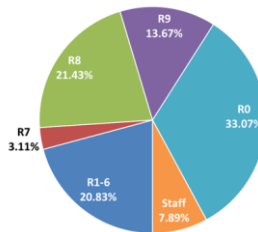
2021 1 Jan to 2021 31 Dec

3732 users were active in the CLE during this period. This is a -19.4% YoY decrease (4,630 active users '20 1 Jan to '20 30 Nov). 2020 was a typical year of high-usage.

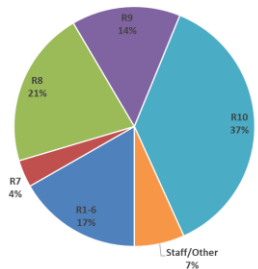

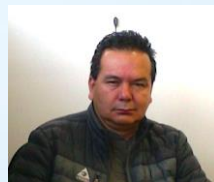
