

Turkey Section Report (Sep. 2022)

Section Vitality

The last section elections were held in Dec. 2021. Next section elections will be held in Dec. 2023. We do not have a tradition of Vice-Chair becoming chair.

The ExCom is composed of the section chair, vice-chair, secretary, treasurer, and two members-at-large. We communicate mostly through messaging apps and informal Zoom meetings to improve efficiency. Three of the ExCom meetings were entered on vTools. Their dates are given below followed by the main agenda item:

We held elections for AP/ED/MTT/EMC joint chapter and YP affinity group. Our YP Affinity Group has also been very active in their sphere of influence and beyond in spreading the philosophy of IEEE and expanding our population. The YP administrative board includes 9 technical (CS, CSS, EMBS, SPS, PES/IES, AP/MTT, ComSoc, Cybersecurity, Blockchain) representatives, which help them carry out various professional/technical activities in many technical areas.

We have a total of 1782 members at the moment. We are more or less maintaining our members – thanks to our Vitality Chair (who happens to be also our AES chapter chair). He interviews leading CEOs and takes questions from members.
