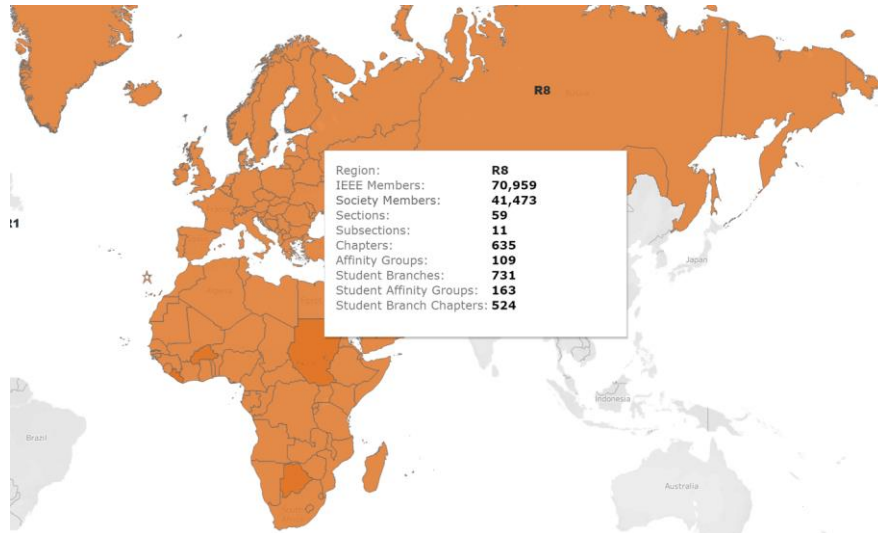

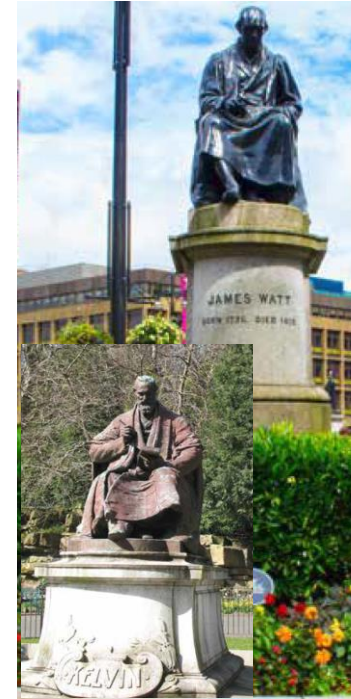


IEEE Region 8 Chapter Chairs Training

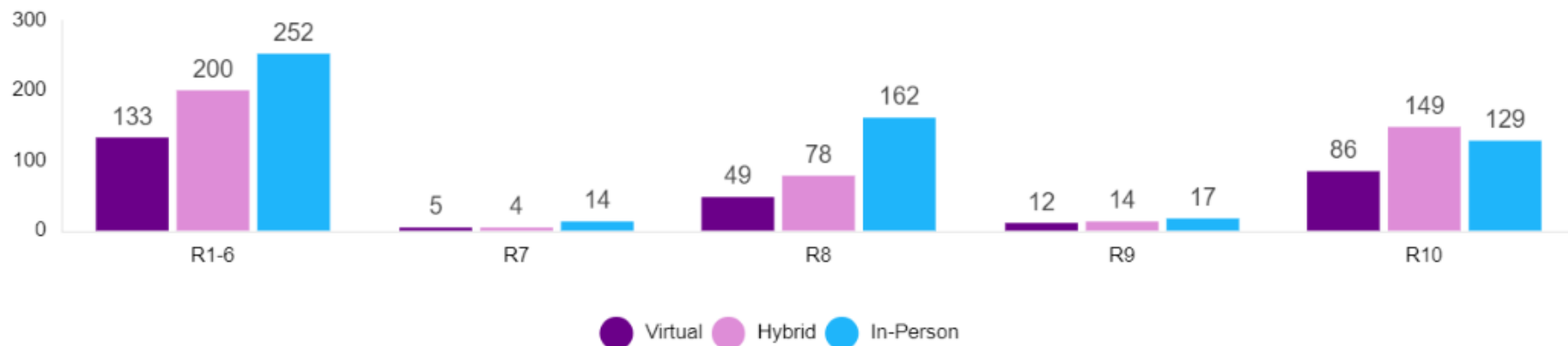
2022 Financial Conferences: Event Format

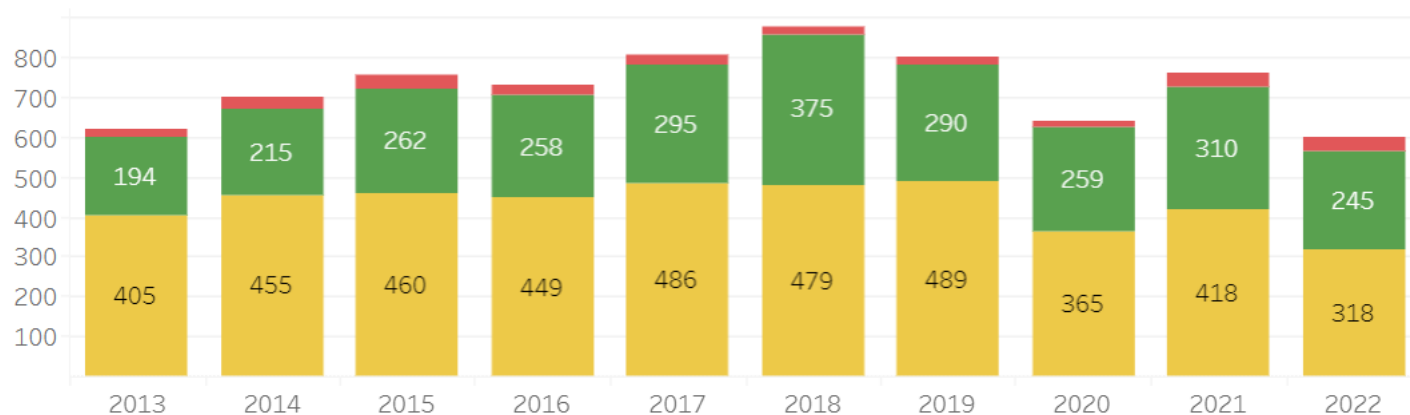


Virtual Events by Quarter



Regional Distribution of Event Formats

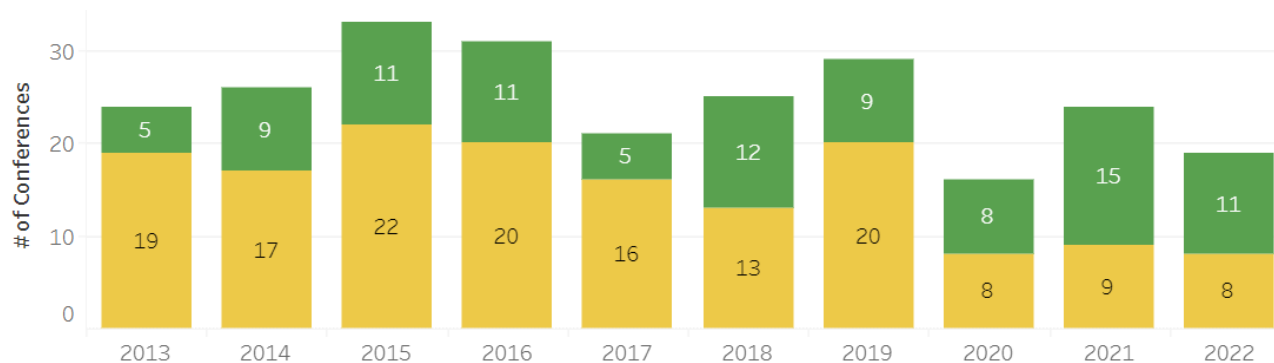

IEEE is committed to working with other National Societies to aid engineers and scientists throughout the world. These cooperative relationships are established through a memorandum of understanding and are known as National Society Agreements.

IEEE currently has more than 70 formal [National Society Agreements](#), spanning over 40 countries/regions. Many of the IEEE Technical Societies have supplemental, or additional, agreements known as "[Sister Society Agreements](#)," with these National Societies, as well as with industry associations.

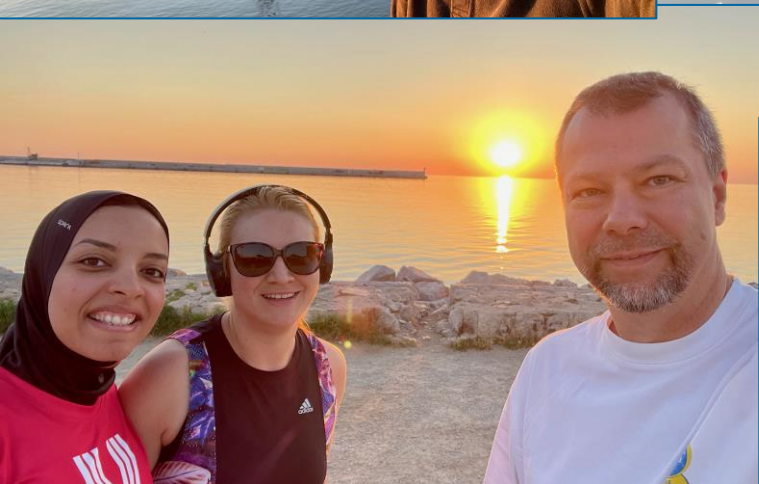
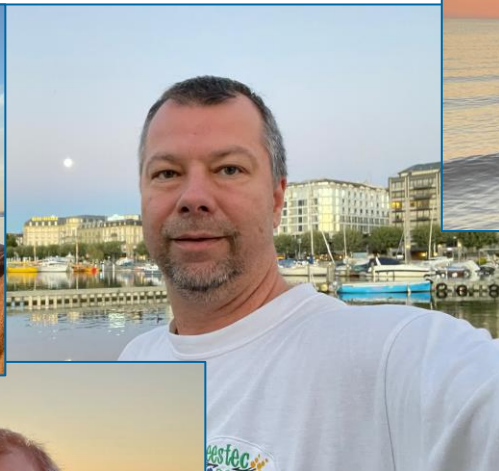
