Two CoCC meetings were held (Jan. 18 and Feb. 27) with detailed minutes containing task distribution and reports on activities. Organization of the third meeting on March 24.

Timely review of the financial and technical co-sponsorship (TCS/FCS) requests

In the first two months of 2023 ten requests of R8 Technical Co-Sponsorship were managed with two declined, seven approved and one under evaluation.

Ensure success of the R8 flagship conferences: call for bids, support, oversight

The RTSI 2023 edition of the RTSI will not be held. The UK & Ireland Section withdrew its candidacy as organizer of the conference in 2023.



The committee has recommended the **Steering Committees** for the following R8 flagship/portfolio conferences (IHTC 2023, ENERGYCON 2024, RTSI 2024) that were approved by the OPCOM of February.

One Virtual Meeting with flagship/portfolio conferences candidates, to answer their questions on the final bid preparation, was held on Jan 12 with the participation of ten bidders and 16 people.

For EUROCON 2025 (Cyprus, Poland, Portugal, UK & Ireland), for IHTC 2024 (Italy, Tunisia), for AFRICON 2025 (Ghana), for RTSI 2025 (Poland, Tunisia, North Macedonia). The meeting was appreciated.

We plan to hold this type of virtual meetings with the bidders in the future as well to ensure a good understanding of the R8 rules and a set of good bids to choose among them the best candidates for organizing future R8 flagship and portfolio conferences.

By the Deadline of January 31st, 2023 the Committee received 8 final bids. Another final bid was received within the second and last DL of February 15th, 2023. Solicitation emails were sent to the proposers who didn't answer to the calls for final bids. The evaluation of the received documents was done and the discussion of the results was held during the CoCC meeting of February 27. Recommendations of the committee and the related report was prepared for the OPCOM meeting of March 13. The new Flagship/portfolio conferences sites will be presented during the R8 meeting.

A task force consisting of two CoCC members is dedicated to this task. An email investigation has begun to obtain the updated list of conference coordinators. Till now 28 section chairs responded.

Ensure good relationship with MGA, MCE, and other regional conference coordinators

An education workshop on "IEEE conference organization for new R8 Section Chairs" with participation of IEEE MCE is organized for March 24, 4-6 pm (EET). All new R8 section chairs are invited, and the workshop is open to all R8 meeting participants.

Industry focused events and conferences

Organization of RTSI 2024 started with the selection of dates, venue, conference organization committee and preliminary budget.

RTSI (Research and Technology for Society and Industry) is the only R8 conference with an industry focus, with many workshops, panel and special events dedicated to industry and with industry contribution. A best practice documents has been prepared to be used as a starting document by the steering committee.

In AFRICON 2023 a workshop dedicated to industry has been organized by the R8 Action for Industry Committee.
