 - b. Current count of LMAGs: 23
2. Sustainable Operation
 - a. The corresponding committee members have got individual activity jobs

 - c. The vTools Officer Reporting is up-to-date
 - d. 67% of LMAGs have less than (3) years of service term.

Progress against goals since the last report

1. Development
 - a. Five (5) new LMAGs have been formed since the 119th R8C Meeting, three (3) of them in 2023
 - b. Four (4) petitions are in progress to form new LMAGs
2. Sustainability
 - a. Continuous check of vTools Event Reporting and vTools Officer Reporting
 - b. Campaign has been made for LM Profil Confirmation
 - c. Regular circulars have been distributed for remembering of the actual To-Do’s.
 - d. The issues a), b), and c) caused significant gaining in the administrative status of both LMAGs and the LM Committee
3. Cooperation and Support
 - a. Annual in-person LMAG meetings are planned in 2023/24.
 - b. One in-person LMAG meeting was held in 2021/22
4. Publicity
 - a. Regular article publication to LMC Newsletter and R8 News is planned
 - b. This activity started only in 2022 Q3
