The "IEEE GREECE SECTION LEAD YOUR SB CAMP LAMIA 2022" was organized on October 2022. The aim of this event was the gathering of the executive committees of the IEEE Greece Section's Student Branches for the purpose of communication and networking between them as well as guidance from the IEEE Greece Section regarding the organization and administration of the student branch throughout the term of the Officers. IEEE Greece Section Young Professionals and Women in Engineering Affinity Groups will also participate in the event.

IEEEXtreme workshops were organized in various locations (e.e.g Chania, Lamia, Athens, Patras) for all Student Branches, for training the teams participating in the IEEEXtreme Programming Contest.

The "Meet the Labs" annual event was organized in 2022 by the IEEE University of Thessaly (Lamia) Student Branch at the University of Thessaly, being recognized as a strategic partner of the Faculty of Science.

Celebrations of the IEEE Day 2022 was held in all Student Branches, including technical talks, social events and awareness campaigns organized by the students and AGs in IEEE Greece Section.

Five workshops took place at various places, specifically 1) Power Engineering dissertations completed between 2020 - 2022 to the public, and awarding of the best dissertation, by the Democritus University of Thrace, Xanthi, 2) "LIFE AS A FAIRYTALE - BUILDING BRIDGES", TryEngineering Month Program, Arta, 3) "NTUA_HACK" at the National Technical University of Athens, 4) "COMPUTER VISION IN SEMICONDUCTOR MICRO-/NANO-STRUCTURES AND DEVICES", a workshop series organized by the IEEE Democritus University of Thrace Student Branch., and 5) "HOW-TO-PRIEEENT WORKSHOP", organized by the IEEE University of Patras Student Branch.

Affinity Groups

The IEEE Greece Section has 5 AGs, specifically, the IEEE National Technical University of Athens HKN AG (Mu Gamma), the IEEE InSIGHT, the IEEE Life Members AG, the Young Professionals AG and the Women-in-Engineering AG. The AGs are partnering with the other IEEE Greece Section OUs and co-organize events.

IEEE Young Professionals Greece organized the 1st IEEE Greece Mentoring Program physical event for students and graduates, in cooperation with the IEEE WIE Greece, IEEE Greece Computer Chapter, IEEE Greece Section, IEEE Life members Greece, IEEE NTUA Student Branch and the IEEE student branch of UNIWA.

Other events are not reported in this section, to avoid duplication of reference.

Chapters

The IEEE Greece Section has 12 technical chapters (Power and Energy Chapter, Communications Chapter, Control Systems Chapter, Signal Processing Chapter, Computer Chapter, Consumer Electronics Chapter, Engineering in Medicine and Biology Chapter, Computational Intelligence Chapter, Electron Devices/Microwave Theory and Techniques/Antennas and Propagation Joint Chapter, Circuits and Systems/Solid-State Circuits Joint Chapter, Vehicular Technology/Aerospace and Electronic Systems Joint Chapter, Industrial Electronics/Industry Applications/Power Electronics Joint Chapter) and more than 20 technical student chapters.

There were 2 events organized recently by the chapters

- 1) WORKSHOP ON GLOBAL OPTIMIZATION METHODS: THEORY, TECHNIQUES, AND MATLAB SIMULATIONS, by the Electron Devices/Microwave Theory and Techniques/Antennas and Propagation Joint Chapter of the IEEE Greece Section
- 2) The Seasonal School on "Smart Integrated Circuit Design Methodology (SMART-IC) 2022" was held in Thessaloniki on Nov. 25-27, 2022 and was organized by the members of our Chapter, Profs. T. Noulis, C. Psychalinos, G. Sirakoulis and A. Hatzopoulos. The event was financially supported by the IEEE CASS "Seasonal School 2022" activity, the IEEE Greece CAS/SSC joint Chapter, the Research Committee of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and industry (ANSYS VTOOL GWF THESSIC) sponsorships (in kind contributions).
