BUCHAREST – PANORAMIC TOUR (2 hours)

Period: 25th of March 2023

Route: Triumph Arch, Victory Square, Magheru Avenue (commercial street), Royal Palace (nowdays the seat of National Art Museum), Atheneum, Revolution Square, Calea Victoriei Avenue, Unirii Square, Parliament Palace

Services included:

- transport by bus;
- english speaking guide;
- driver.

Services not included:

- entrance tickets at the monuments;
- photo and video fees;
- other services not specified on the itinerary.

Details:

Pick up from Radisson Blu Hotel Bucharest at 18:00 and start to explore the capital of Romania, through a panoramic tour by bus. During the tour you'll have the chance to see the most important sights of Romanian Capital, such as: **Triumph Arch, Victory Square, Magheru Avenue (commercial street), Royal Palace** (nowdays the seat of **National Art Museum**), **Atheneum, Revolution Square, Calea Victoriei Avenue, Unirii Square, Parliament Palace**, a "giant" built during the "golden age" of the dictatorial regime and born in the mind of a man for whom the notion of "reasonable size" did not exist. The Guinness Book of World Records lists the building in second place according to its 330,000 sq.m. surface, that is after the Pentagon building, and in third place according to its 2,550,000 c.m. volume.

If time permitted, short stops for photos and short walks at **Royal Palace, Revolution Square** and **Parliament Palace**.

Drop off at your dinner location at Bragadiru Palace at 20:00.

Departure to the hotel Radisson Blu from Bragadiru Palace at 23:00.

Departure to Bran, visit of Castle Bran - legendary castle of Dracula.

Lunch at Sergiana Restaurant.

Return to Bucharest.
