Section Vitality

The last election for the term 2021-2023 was held in November 2020. The elected/appointed officers are listed under the <u>Executive Committee</u> (ExCom) of the section's <u>website</u>. According to the section's <u>bylaws</u>, the next election is foreseen during the last quarter of 2023. Information about this election has already been provided to all section members together with a request for officer proposals.

Students

Overall, 6 different student branches (SB) belong to the section. The latest, i.e., the student branch UMIT Tirol, was officially approved by IEEE in July 2022. This new branch in the western part of Austria will now be step-by-step integrated into the section activities as well as also represented on the related section website.

Affinity Groups

The section currently has a young professional (YP) and women in engineering (WIE) affinity group. Usually, they organize several events and activities during a year but quite similar to the student branches fewer events have been organized during the COVID-19 pandemic. The event was very successful since around 50 section members participated in this networking event. The visit to the IEEE Europe Office in Vienna was part of this event where the colleagues from the office showed us their premises.
