#### **Points of Concern**

In many awards not enough quality nominations were received. This is a long standing issue that is repeated year over year.

## **Proposals for improvements**

The Committee will undertake a deep revision of the R8 portfolio of Awards with the goal of improving consistency and establishing a clear hierarchy, also associated with the prize amounts. The A&R Committee will reconsider the overall structure, trying to eliminate duplicities and to cover gaps, in order to make the portfolio more reflecting of the overall volunteer activity in the Region. The goal is to submit recommendations to OpCom before the end of the year.
