Affinity Groups

The IEEE Greece Section has 5 AGs, specifically, the IEEE National Technical University of Athens HKN AG (Mu Gamma), the IEEE InSIGHT, the IEEE Life Members AG, the Young Professionals AG and the Women-in-Engineering AG. The AGs are partnering with the other IEEE Greece Section OUs and co-organize events.

In particular Section's Young Professionals AG organized the following events within 2023:

- Announcement of the 3rd round of the IEEE Greece Mentoring Program, in order to support young engineers at their first professional steps. The Mentors share their experience and provide guidance in achieving specific professional goals, improving skills and enhancing career development (<u>https://site.ieee.org/greece-vp/mentoring-program/</u>)
- On 25th January 2023, it co-organized with Women in Engineering AG an online coffee talk entitled "Operation and planning of smart distribution networks challenges and current trends" with Dr Angelina Syrri via Microsoft Teams.
- On 2nd May 2023, it co-organized with the Power & Energy Society Chapter and NTUA Student Branch (IEEE PES NTUA) a physical event at NTUAentitled "Energy Today: Challenges and Prospects for the Future", the details of which are reported hereafter in Chapter's activities.
- On 29th June 2023, during a timely panel session entitled 'Young Professionals Panel Session on Future Power System Workforce' that took place at the IEEE PES PowerTech Belgrade 2023 conference, the Young Professionals AG Chair, Panos Kotsampopoulos, presented the activities of IEEE Young Professionals along, with insights about relevant initiatives. In this Panel Session, a wide range of skills and knowledge have been discussed, including technical expertise and knowledge (e.g., design/modelling/programming skills) required for most power engineering jobs related to grid connection studies, power system operation, power electronics, system planning, energy sector coupling, electricity markets etc.

Chapters

The IEEE Greece Section has 12 technical chapters (Power and Energy Chapter, Communications Chapter, Control Systems Chapter, Signal Processing Chapter, Computer Chapter, Consumer Electronics Chapter, Engineering in Medicine and Biology Chapter, Computational Intelligence Chapter, Electron Devices/Microwave Theory and Techniques/Antennas and Propagation Joint Chapter, Circuits and Systems/Solid-State Circuits Joint Chapter, Vehicular Technology/Aerospace and Electronic Systems Joint Chapter, Industrial Electronics/Industry Applications/Power Electronics Joint Chapter) and more than 20 technical student chapters.

The following events have been organized within 2023 byrespective chapters:

- On 2nd May 2023, the Power & Energy Chapter in co-operation withNTUA Student Branch and the Young Professionals AG organized a physical event at NTUAentitled "Energy Today: Challenges and Prospects for the Future" which was attended by more than 80 participants. During this event, an interactive and inspiring panel discussion with Prof. Nikos Hatziargyriou, Prof. Stavros Papathanassiou and Prof. Anthony Papavasiliou was scheduledinvolving topics such as energy efficiency, renewable energy penetration, energy storage and e-mobility. Technical presentations on smart grids, e-mobility and green buildings were also delivered by Schneider Electric.Students demonstrated great interest, raised interesting questions and shared their view on these complex challenges that engineers are currently facing worldwide.
- On 28th June 2023, during the "12th International Conference on Modern Circuits and Systems Technologies" held in Athens, Greece, the Electron Devices/Microwave Theory and Techniques/Antennas and Propagation Joint Chapter organized a Special Session on "Complementary aspects of Artificial Intelligence, Unmanned Aerial Vehicles, and Future



Wireless Networks" including works on "Service recommendation for a group of users on the internet of things using the most popular service", "The human blockage impact on ARIS assisted D2D communication systems", "DOA estimation for 6G communication systems", "3D adaptive beam forming approach with a fine-tuned deep neural network", "A review of deep learning solutions in 360° video streaming", "FDTD modeling of graphene-based materials and its application in sensing devices".

- On 26th th April 2023 the Vehicular Technology/Aerospace and Electronic Systems Joint Chapter organized a technical meeting on "Sub-Terahertz propagation in 6G wireless communications" during which the potential of sub-THz frequencies in future 6G wireless communications systems has been analysed. The opportunities, the challenges and propagation issues were also discussed. Furthermore, recent state-of-the-art research was highlighted and new research gaps have been investigated that would help elaborate on further studies in sub-THz frequencies in Greece.
- The Circuits and Systems/Solid-State Circuits Joint Chapter has organized two meetings; the first one was held on 15th March 2023 concerning selection and invitation of DLPs as well as search for potential funding sources for the chapter while the second was organized on 4th June 2023 devoted to plan new events and seasonal schools.

Industry

This year an invited visit of students of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki has been organized in the industrial plant of the high-voltage laboratory of ELEMKO SA. Moreover, an industrial project has been initiated in the same University with Raycap SA company concerning surge protection of electric vehicles.
