- List of challenges we are facing:
 - Limited budget for activities and events
 - Limited outreach and engagement with potential members and industry partners
 - Competition from other professional organizations in the field
 - The potential for decreased funding and support from IEEE and industry partners due to economic changes
- Areas that we need support from R8
 - Traditional membership to be given at a cheaper/discounted rate.
 - > Older IEEE members incentivization and support to transition to Senior membership.
 - IEEE Digital library for local Universities to support students with their projects & research.
 - Reiterate suggestions made by the past chair to provide an option for Quarterly Payments of membership fees. This will make renewal decisions easier and reduce member attrition.
