Points of Concern

1. Number of WIE members per Section is comparatively lower than the potential of Sections. All Sections are recommended to conduct WIE membership campaigns to add more members.

2. There are 20 Sections without WIE AGs. We will work with these Sections to initiate WIE AGs. All Sections are also encouraged to reach out directly to us for any support for local WIE AG vitality.

3. WIE membership value adds needs to be better defined at the global level to attract more members. We have given this feedback to the Global WIE Committee as well.
