# Background

- Region Realignment process lasted for a few years and in November 2022, a number of changes to the Region structure were approved by the IEEE Board of Directors:
  - Merging of Regions 1 and 2 into new Region 2
  - Splitting of Region 10 into Regions 10 and 11
  - Adding a second position from R8 to the MGA Board. **Zone representative**
- Two zones are defined in R8. Zone representative has a term of two years coincident with the Region Director. To provide diversity, Zone representative must come from a different zone from the Director.

# Background

- Region 8 appointed the first Zone representative in October 2022, for one year, that was later extended for a second year (2023-2024).
- After that, formal election procedures were established for subsequent elections
- This year we will be electing the zone representative (coming from Zone 8.B) to serve at the MGA Board for 2025-2026.

## Definition of Zone representative

- The position is an MGA position and functions are defined in the MGA Operations Manual, section 2.7.B:
- Represents the membership of his/her zone, along with the Region Director
- Serves as a voting member of the MGA Board
- May serve as a representative of MGA to other IEEE organizational units
- May serve on MGA Committees or other organizational units
- Any other function assigned by the respective Region Bylaws.

- **R8-3.1.1 OPERATING COMMITTEE (OPCOM)**
- The Region 8 Officers constitute the Region 8 Operating Committee (OpCom). Persons holding more than one office in the Region 8 OpCom shall also be limited to one vote in the Region 8 OpCom.
