Deadline: 31 March 2024



– Important Information about CFP

- Funding amount: \$1,000 - \$10,000 per project (transferred to Sections)
- Term of funding: Up to 6 months following the project start date
- Submission limitation: Each team may submit only one proposal
- Progress report: Every month after the project's approved start date
- Final report: Within 60 days of the project's completion including an accounting of expenses and impact assessment information
