Section Vitality

An official Board meeting was held on September 17 (virtually). A General Assembly was organized on February 8; the next one will be held on December 3 (both in Paris).

On December 7, 2023, the Section gathered 3884 members. Compared with December 31, 2022 (3563 members), this is a significant increase. More specifically, this increase is mainly due to Members (2079 vs. 1931), Associate Members (147 vs. 89) and Life Members (92 vs. 67 excluding Life Senior and Life Fellows). It is very likely that some new members do not fill in their profile properly and, therefore, are accounted for Associate Members instead of Members; the Section will to contact them. The same rule may apply to Student Members which could have been accounted for Graduate Student Members if they had filled in their educational background correctly.

The current number is 3591 members as of October 1, 2024 (within the renewal period).

New elections for the Section were held from October 30 to November 30, 2022. As France Section is concerned, both the Section Chair and Vice-Chair are elected (the Vice-Chair does not implicitly become the next Chair). Six positions (provided below) were renewed:

- Chair: René Garello
- Vice-Chair: Maria Trocan
- Treasurer: Jaafar Gaber
- Secretary: Richard Perdriau (re-elected)
- Officer for Conferences and Workshops: François Rivet
- Officer for Member Technical Activities: Serge dos Santos

These results were announced on December 1, 2022, and formally validated by the General Assembly on December 20, 2022.

According to the Section's statutes, another position (Officer for WiE activities) must be included in the Section's ComEx. Following the reactivation of the Section's WiE Affinity Group, its acting Chair (Florence Sèdes) was officially elected to that position in November 2023.

Still according to the Section's statutes, the Section's ComEx must include a Student Representative. A call for volunteers was launched, leading to only one candidate (Johan Boukhenfouf). The candidate was appointed to the position by the General Assembly on February 8, 2024.

Moreover, according to the Section's standing orders, 3 Chapter Chairs are voting members of the Section's Board. The 3 candidates (Mohammed Chadli – CS23, Sihem Mesnager – IT12, Smaïl Tedjini – AP03) to these positions were consequently appointed by the General Assembly on February 8, 2024.

14 conference technical sponsorship requests were filed for 2024, and 13 were accepted (12 in 2023). 11 have already been filed for 2025 (9 accepted).

LM: 4 events were declared in 2024 (up to October 1), including two conferences ('Modeling and Uses of the Concept of Consciousness' by G. Sabah, 'The Origins of AI' by M. Najim).

16 Chapters (out of 27) reported on time and received rebates in 2023. Moreover, activity bonuses were awarded to CIS11, MAG33, SMC28 and SSC37.

Up to October 1, a total of 55 events were declared by all Chapters in 2024 (89 in the whole 2023 year), 17 by SB Chapters (9 in 2023).

A new Chapter (UFFC20) was created in March 2024. Serge Dos Santos is currently the UFFC20 interim Chair until new elections have been organized.

A petition has just been submitted and endorsed for the creation of an Intelligent Transportation Systems Chapter.

A project for the creation of a French Chapter of the Systems Council is underway.

A new CAS Student Branch Chapter was created in Grenoble Alpes University in June 2024.

Following the sudden passing away of the C16 Chapter Chair in 2022, no other ExCom member could be reached out for his succession until the end of 2023. Elections were subsequently launched on February 26, 2024. The new C16 Chair is Arthur Vervaet.

New Chapter elections took place for AP03 (Chair: Smaïl Tedjini), IM09 (Chair: Slavisa Jovanovic), PE31 (Chair: Gabriel Bareux), PHO26 (Chair: Frédéric Grillot), and RL07 (Chair: Hichame Maanane).



A meeting of Chapter Chairs (plus the Section ExCom and volunteers) will be organized in Paris on October 23. The matter of bi-annual workshops on IEEE cross-disciplinary topics will then be discussed, along with their interaction with Action for Industry.

Industry

The Section participated to the RTSI 2024 Conference in Lecco (Italy) on September 18-19, through Frédérique Vallée (Steering Committee) and Serge Dos Santos (Industry Events Committee).

The Action for Industry Committee was involved in the SYP 2024 Congress in Grenoble.

A workshop on industrial involvement in European projects is planned for the IEEE-MTS OCEANS 2025 conference in Brest.

Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

13.76 % of Section members are women (and another 14.37 % did not indicate any gender).

The current Section ExCom includes 2 women (out of 8). 4 Chapter Chairs (CAS04, IT12, SMC28 and SSC37), plus the LM Affinity Group Chair, the WiE Affinity Group Chair and Vice-Chair, and the Young Professionals Affinity Group Chair, are women. 1 SB Chair (University of Toulouse) and 2 SB Vice-Chairs (INSA Centre Val de Loire and Jean Monnet University) are women.

Activities since the last report

The creation of new Chapters is working really well in the Section in 2024: UFFC has already been created, ITS is ongoing, Systems is planned.

Young Professionals are being more and more involved in Chapter Boards, including Chapter Chairs (C16).

The cooperation between Student Branches and Young Professionals is becoming more and more intricate, with the coorganization of several events and joint participations in conferences (SYP, Baltic Electronics Conference...).

Planned activities

The overhaul of the Section's Web site will continue, with the inclusion of specific Chapter and Affinity Group pages, news, and an automated feed from vTools Events to an online event calendar.

An application will be filed for 3 other Milestones (Micral N – the first commercial personal computer, invention of turbocodes by Claude Berrou and Alain Glavieux, and General Gustave Ferrié – wireless telegraph) in France.

The Section will continue its active support to conferences (9 accepted for 2025 up to October 1).
