

- The Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) was founded in 1963. IEEE France, founded in 1969 is a Geographical Unit of IEEE inc., belonging to Region 8 (Afrique/Europe/ Moyen Orient)
- IEEE France is formally a French Non-for-Profit Association (loi 1901), with aims: "To contribute to the advancement of innovation and technology excellence for the benefit of humanity"

IEEE has near 450,000 members in 160 countries, including almost 5,000 in France.

There are less than 25% female students in engineering schools and courses, and only 10-15% in digital/informatics courses!

Nearly 50% of women give up jobs in the tech industry every year!

In France, it is estimated that there is a shortfall of 30,000 engineers a year.






