Goals and KPIs

Mission

This Ad-Hoc committee shall study services and infrastructures and prepare a framework to make technical knowledge and practical skills more accessible and support the expansion of Region 8 educational activities

Goals/KPIs

1. Identify existing resources
2. Develop guidelines for conducting events to produce high-quality, usable content in various formats, such as videos, recordings, etc.
3. Analyse frameworks for efficiently distributing educational content and materials, including storage and promotion strategies (results to share with IEEE towards prioritizing development of existing or new tools)

Progress made since R8 Vienna meeting (March 2024)

1. Are all tools equally popular? We prepared and run a **survey** (by 36 Section Chairs) regarding usage of the IEEE and non-IEEE tools. *Next is to widen the survey and discuss results with IEEE ☐ Priorities for IEEE*
2. To evaluate the next steps and focus areas, we prepared and executed a small **survey** on priorities.
3. Prepared a **longer-term plan** and a draft funding proposal
4. **Reviewed** additional **tools**, and **Updated tool/event guidelines**
5. Submitted a **recommendation to MGA** for vTools Events to include hosting additional data (e.g., a link to recording etc.)
6. Co-organised and presented **R8 Blitz info session** with R8 PEAC

- Every Section Chair knows vTools
- Most know Collabratec, YouTube and IEEE.tv
- Poor knowledge of CLE, ILN, TAB Resource Centre
- Big diversity on cost expectations: most want free; some ok with ~\$3-\$10
