Section Vitality

Two official board meetings were held on July 3 and September 17 (both virtually). Moreover, two General Assemblies were organized on February 8 and December 3 (both in Paris).

On December 31, 2024, the Section gathered 3793 members. Compared with December 31, 2023 (3903 members), a 3 % decrease can be observed. More specifically, all categories are more of less stable, with a small decrease in (Life) Member grades (2138 vs. 2215) and (Graduate) Student Members (828 vs. 860), and a slight increase in (Life) Senior Member grades (571 vs. 558). Figures still remain a little better than on December 31, 2022 (3748 members).

Section elections were held from October 30 to November 30, 2022. As France Section is concerned, both the Section Chair and Vice-Chair are elected (the Vice-Chair does not implicitly become the next Chair). Six positions (provided below) were renewed:

- Chair: René Garello
- Vice-Chair: Maria Trocan
- Treasurer: Jaafar Gaber
- Secretary: Richard Perdriau (re-elected)
- Officer for Conferences and Workshops: François Rivet
- Officer for Member Technical Activities: Serge dos Santos

These results were announced on December 1, 2022, and formally validated by the General Assembly on December 20, 2022.

According to the Section's statutes, another position (Officer for WiE activities) must be included in the Section's ComEx. Following the reactivation of the Section's WiE Affinity Group, its acting Chair (Florence Sèdes) was officially elected to that position in November 2023.

Still according to the Section's statutes, the Section's ComEx must include a Student Representative. A call for volunteers was launched, leading to only one candidate (Johan Boukhenfouf). The candidate was appointed to the position by the General Assembly on February 8, 2024.

Moreover, according to the Section's standing orders, 3 Chapter Chairs are voting members of the Section's Board. The 3 candidates (Mohammed Chadli – CS23, Sihem Mesnager – IT12, Smaïl Tedjini – AP03) to these positions were consequently appointed by the General Assembly on February 8, 2024.

The next elections will start before Summer 2025, so that results can be announced and validated by the General Assembly to be organized in December 2025. The current President (one mandate) and Secretary (two consecutive mandates) are not allowed to run for office.

16 Chapters (out of 27) reported on time and received rebates for 2023 activities. Moreover, activity bonuses were awarded to CIS11, MAG33, SMC28 and SSC37.

A total of 137 events were declared by all Chapters in 2024 (89 in 2023), 41 by SB Chapters (9 in 2023). This is a very significant increase compared to the previous year. Congratulations to all Chapters and Student Branch Chapters!

A new Chapter (UFFC20) was created in March 2024. Serge Dos Santos is currently the UFFC20 interim Chair until new elections have been organized.

Another new Chapter (ITS38) was created in October 2024, with Mostafa Ameli as interim Chair.

The creation of a French Chapter of the Systems Council (projected interim Chair: Omar Hammami) is underway.

New Student Branch Chapters were created in Grenoble Alpes University (CAS) and Université de Bordeaux (CS) in 2024. The creation of a UFFC Student Branch Chapter in INSA Centre Val de Loire is scheduled in 2025.

New Chapter elections took place in 2024 for AP03 (Chair: Smaïl Tedjini), IM09 (Chair: Slavisa Jovanovic), PE31 (Chair: Gabriel Bareux), PHO26 (Chair: Frédéric Grillot), RL07 (Chair: Hichame Maanane), and SMC28 (Chair: Inès Saad). The C16 Chair (Arthur Vervaet) resigned, and was replaced by Roua Touihri (former Vice-Chair).

A general meeting of Chapter Chairs (plus the Section ExCom and volunteers) was organized in Paris on October 23, and gathered 14 Chapter Board representatives (C16, CIS11, COM19, CS23, EMB18, EMC27, IM09, ITS38, OE22, PE31, PHO36, SEN39, SSC37, UFFC20).

Industry

The Action for Industry committee was reorganized, with 3 active ambassadors (Philippe Courmontagne, Laurent Couteleau, Serge Dos Santos).

A MOU was signed between the newly created UFFC Chapter and the French company Vermon, with a yearly financial sponsorship.

AFI organized Industry 4.0 events within SYP 2024 (Grenoble, France) and RTSI 2024 (Lecco, Italy).

The fifth edition of "Assises de l'Industrie 4.0" was organized in INSA Centre Val de Loire in September 2024.

Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

13.33 % of Section members are women (and another 12.29 % did not indicate any gender).

The current Section ExCom includes 2 women (out of 8). 4 Chapter Chairs (CAS04, IT12, SMC28 and SSC37), plus the LM Affinity Group Chair, the WiE Affinity Group Chair and Vice-Chair, and the YP Affinity Group Chair, are women. 1 SB Chair (University of Toulouse) and 2 SB Vice-Chairs (INSA Centre Val de Loire and Jean Monnet University) are women.

Activities since the last report

The Section organized the previous R8 Committee Meeting in Bordeaux on October 19-20.

A global overhaul of the Section's Web site was carried out.

The YP affinity group organized a "Génies de l'Avenir" (Geniuses of the Future) event on March 4, 2025, to celebrate the World Engineering Day.

STMicroelectronics and the LM affinity group filed an application for a Milestone on Integrated Circuits for Satellite Digital Radio.

Planned activities

The Chapter Chair Meeting (October 23) paved the way to the organization of dedicated quarterly IEEE France Days in 2025. These workshops will be related to environment/climate change, energy, and the digital world. Planned topics are:

- Adapting Energy Systems to Climate Change
- Digital Twins
- Industry 4.0
- Cybersecurity

These meetings will be organized on one afternoon and the following morning, leaving the full evening for networking activities.

3 applications for Milestones are being prepared, involving the LM affinity group:

- The Micral N (first commercial microprocessor-based computer)
- The Invention of Turbo Codes
- General Gustave Ferrié, a Pioneer of Wireless Telegraphy

The YP affinity group will organize a Mentoring Meet event (in cooperation with Estonia, Italy and Switzerland), as well as contribute to WESYP 2025 (in Germany).



WiE and YP affinity groups will set up specific social activities during the EMC Europe 2025 Conference in Paris. This will be the second time, following the 2024 conference in Bruges.

AFI will appoint new active ambassadors. Joint student/YP/AFI events are planned between the Estonia and France sections. Industry 4.0 events will be organized in future RTSI events.

Another objective consists in signing other MOUs between French companies and Chapters.
