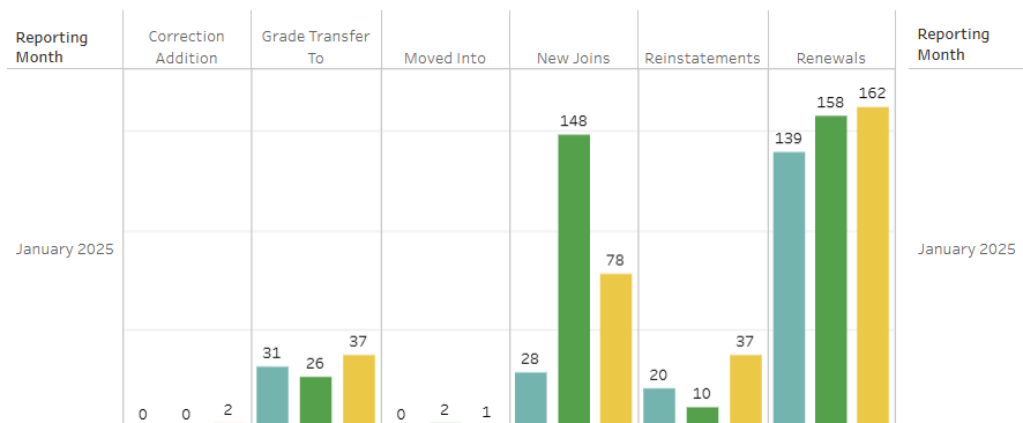

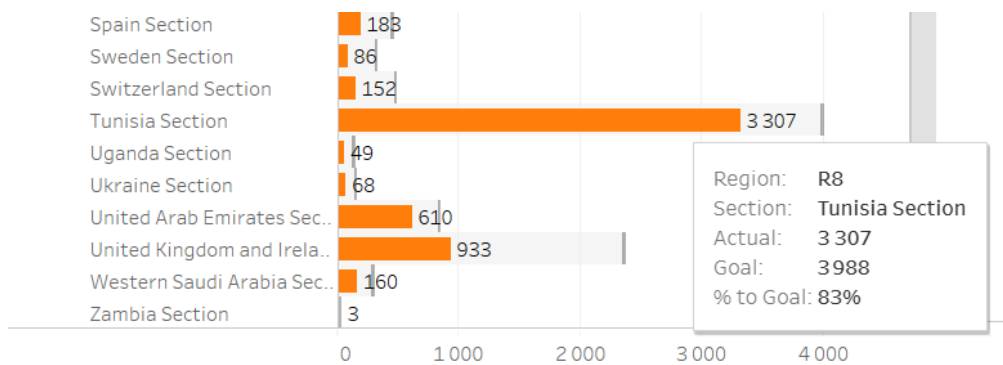

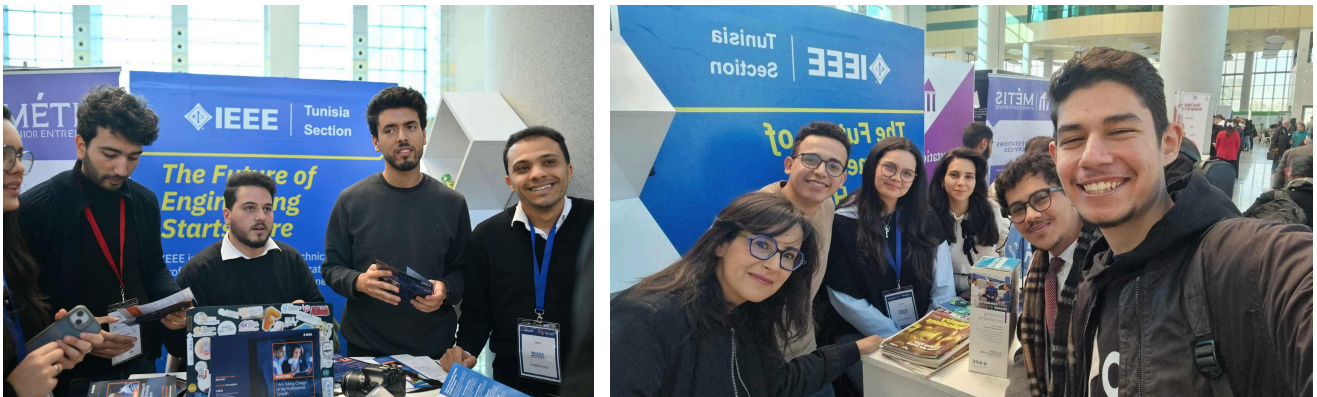
IEEE Tunisia Section ensures a good equilibrium of the percentage of female members and volunteers as well as geographic distribution.

## 8. How Region 8 Can Support Your Section, Members, and Activities

The Tunisia Section struggles with retaining student members after graduation, primarily due to the high cost of professional membership relative to local salaries. While the 50% discount under the minimum income option helps, it remains insufficient, and the electronic membership fee is still higher than the discounted traditional membership. To address this challenge, it is crucial to reassess professional membership fees based on each country's Gross National Income (GNI).
